- 1.1 At its meeting on 6 December 2016, the Children and Young People Scrutiny Committee considered a report on Budget Options 2017-2020, which included options regarding school crossing patrols. Following this members began a wider discussion on road safety around schools and decided this issue required further work and consideration.
