#### 1.0 Background

- 1.1 In November 2006 the Children and Young People Overview and Scrutiny Committee established the Ofsted Subgroup to enable members to engage with and add value to the school improvement agenda.
- 1.2 The remit of the Subgroup was approved by the Committee in March 2007 and the terms of reference were subsequently revised by the Committee in October 2013, broadening the remit to include Ofsted inspections of the Local Authority in relation to school improvement and of children's centres and daycare providers.
- 1.3 At its meeting on 16 September 2014, in response to the Ofsted judgement that children's services were "inadequate", the Young People and Children Scrutiny Committee decided to expand the remit of the Ofsted Subgroup to include consideration of reports on local authority safeguarding arrangements and to request that the Subgroup look at this issue in more detail. The changes to the terms of reference were subsequently approved at the Committee's October 2014 meeting. In May 2016, the wording was amended to 'consider inspection reports and performance information for services for children in need of help and protection, looked after children and care leavers' in order to clarify that the Ofsted Subgroup could consider any matters arising from the 2014 Ofsted inspection report of Manchester children's services.
- 1.4 In May 2016, the Committee also revised the terms of reference to include consideration of inspection reports and performance information for Manchester City Council-owned children's homes
- 1.5 In June 2017, the Committee agreed to remove the following point from the Ofsted Subgroup's terms of reference on the grounds that the Committee receives a Post Ofsted Improvement Plan Update report at each of its meeting and that these issues should be considered by the full membership of the Children and Young People Scrutiny Committee at the Committee's meetings.
  - consider inspection reports and performance information for services for children in need of help and protection, looked after children and care leavers

#### 2.0 Proposed Revisions to the Terms of Reference

- 2.1 In July 2017, the Committee received a Post-Ofsted Improvement Plan Update on a recent Ofsted Monitoring Visit. At this meeting, the Committee agreed that the Ofsted Subgroup should hold an additional meeting, to which all Committee Members should be invited, to consider the Ofsted Monitoring Visit feedback in more detail and that the terms of reference of the Subgroup should be amended to bring this within its remit. Therefore, it is proposed to revise the terms of reference to include:
  - consider inspection reports and performance information for services for children in need of help and protection, looked after children and care leavers
