1. Introduction

- 1.1 In accordance with Sections 15-17 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989, the Committee must again review the appointments to Joint Authorities and Joint Committees where the Council has three or more seats on these bodies, to ensure representation of the Council's different political groups.
- 1.2 In determining the allocation of seats on these bodies between the different political groups, the Council, so far as possible, must give effect to the principles of political balance.
- 1.3 The Joint Authorities and Joint Committees to which the Council makes appointments, and which are affected by these provisions, are as follows:

2. Joint Authorities

2.1 The present appointments to the Joint Authorities are as follows:

Fire and Rescue Authority (5 seats)

The Majority Group is now entitled to 4 seats and the Opposition Group to 1 seat. The following members are currently appointed –

Councillors Ankers, Cooper, Curley, Judge and Shannon.

Waste Disposal Authority (3 seats)

The Majority Group is entitled to 2 seats and the opposition to 1 seat. The following members are currently appointed –

Councillors Glover, N. Murphy and Swannick
