## Purpose of report

The Constitutional and Nomination Committee is asked to make recommendations to the Council about the size and composition of the Council's committees and to appoint chairs and deputy chairs of the committees detailed in this report.

## Recommendations

The Committee is asked to make recommendations to Council about:

1. The size of the Council's committees;
2. The appointment of members to serve on the various committees listed in the report;
3. The appointment of members to serve as chairs of scrutiny committees, chairs of non executive committees, and the deputy chairs of the Planning and Highways Committee, and the Licensing and the Licensing and Appeals Committees;
4. The appointment of a member for the purpose of answering questions at Council on the work of the Standards Committee, in accordance with Article 9 of the Council Constitution.

## Background

1. Government regulations require the Council to appoint membership of its committees in accordance with the principles of political balance as far as reasonably practicable. The principles of political balance are summarised below:
a. If there is more than one political group represented at a council, then seats on any committee cannot be allocated to only one political group;
b. that the majority of seats on the relevant committee are allocated to the majority group on the council;
c. Subject to (a) and (b), the total number of seats on all of the Council's committees are allocated between political groups in proportion to each group's representation on the Council;
d. Subject to (a), (b) and (c), the seats on each individual committee or sub-committee are allocated between the political groups in proportion to each group's membership of the Council, and
e. where councillors are not members of a group, they are appointed to any seats which are left unallocated.

## Political Balance

This report has been prepared on the basis of the following calculation of the political balance of the Council's members.

2. Government regulations require the Council to appoint membership of its committees in accordance with the principles of political balance as far as reasonably practicable. Due to the composition of the Council after the election, there are no restrictions to the number of seats on each committee. Details of the suggested number of available seats on each committee are included below. The Committee is asked to make recommendations to the Council about the membership of these committees.

## Other Committees

3. Some of the Council's committees are subject to specific rules about membership. These details are included below. The Committee is asked to make recommendations to Council about the membership of these committees.

## Employee Appeals Committee

4. The composition of the Committee was amended in October 2013 to consist of the following structure:

- the Executive Member with a relevant portfolio (i.e. Executive Member for the service in which the employee was working or the Executive Member with a portfolio relevant to the specific subject area of the appeal) or an appropriate Assistant Executive Member,
- and two members drawn from drawn from the Council's Executive Members or the Assistant Executive Members, or elected members drawn from a prescribed 'pool' of 15 members.

5. The Constitutional and Nomination Committee is asked to confirm this composition and agree the members in the prescribed pool.

## Health and Wellbeing Board

6. The membership of the Health and Wellbeing Board comprises of councillors as well as NHS and council officers. The membership was agreed at the meeting of Council on 27 March 2013 and subsequent amendments have been agreed through the Constitutional and Nomination Committee and the Council.
7. Following a previous review of the governance structure of the Board, the membership of the Board is set out below. The Board has also agreed that each member should have a named substitute. Proposals for further changes to the Board's membership are likely later in the year to reflect the establishment of the Manchester Local Care Organisation.
