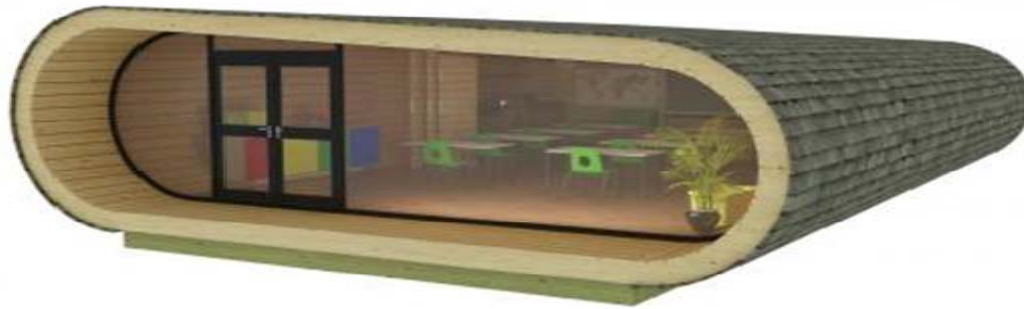

What The Limes do

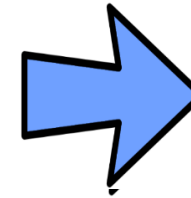
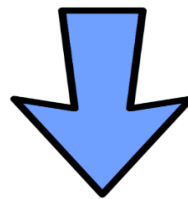

Activities & Partnership working in community





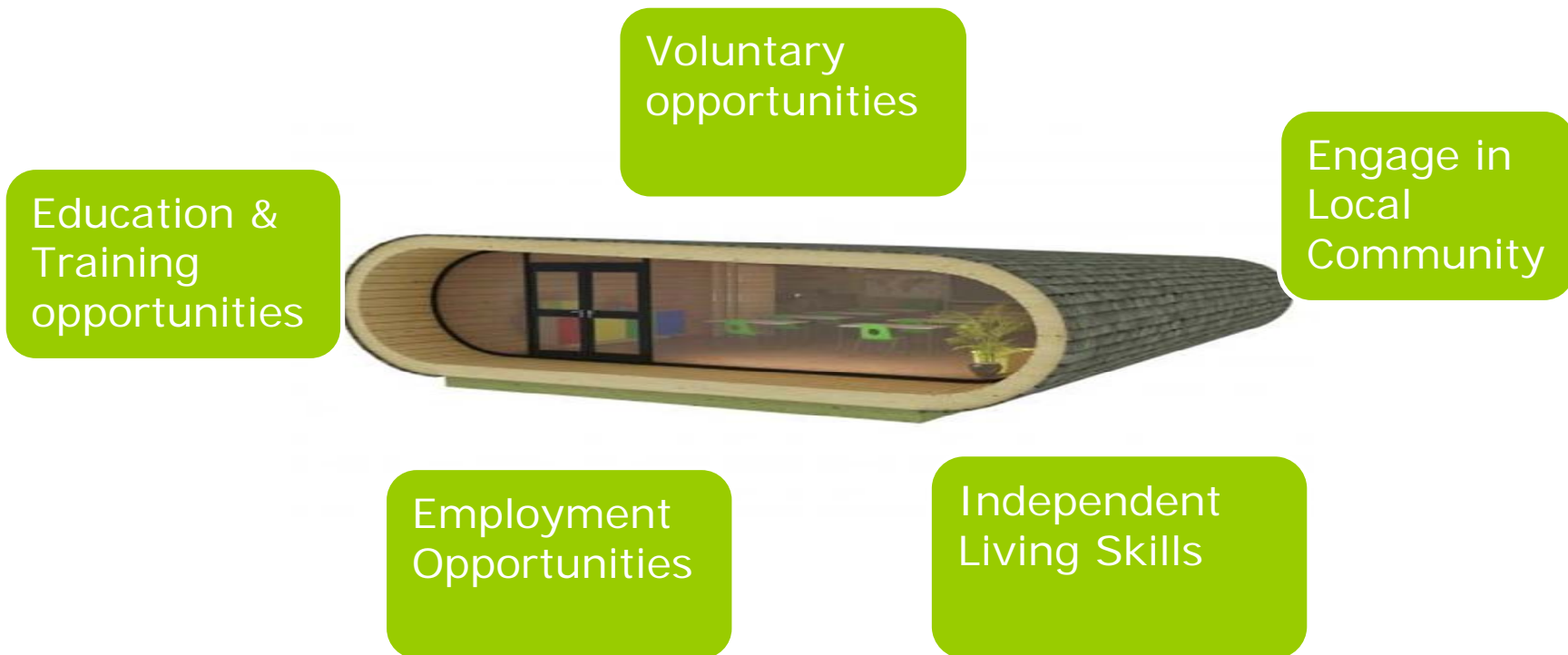
Achievements so far

- ❑ **MAES** – Secured over £60k funding over last 3 years
- ❑ **Streetgames** – Secured over £12k funding for next 3 years
- ❑ **Street 2 Feet** –over 400 homeless attendees annually.
- ❑ **Northwest Homeless Equality Football League** – Over 11 local homeless projects participating
- ❑ **Apprenticeships** - 7 clients in last year on apprenticeship scheme, scheme on-going
- ❑ **Sports Leadership Course Level 1/ Tenancy Training course Entry Level 3** – 150 clients achieved accredited qualification
- ❑ **RV project** –8 clients completed voluntary programme abroad
- ❑ **DWP/Jobcentre Plus** –30 people within the local community back into employment
- ❑ **Voluntary Opportunities** - Over 100 voluntary opportunities created.
