- Improved A&E Performance:
 - NMGH achieved 2014/15 A&E target: 95.2 %


Supporting Patients Home:

- Delayed transfers of care reduced by 55 % during the last three years

 - Mortality rates in 14/15 reduced: HSMR 82.8 %






Healthier Together Proposal: NMGH General Hospital
