1 Introduction

1.1 At the Health and Well Being Board meeting on the 23rd January, the three Manchester Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) will each give a presentation highlighting their commissioning priorities and how they will be addressing them. This paper provides links to their 2012-2015 Commissioning plans so Board members can, if they so wish, familiarise themselves with the detail prior to the meeting.

2 Background / Authorisation Update

- **2.1** On the 31st March 2013, NHS Manchester will cease to exist. From this date, the 3 Manchester CCGs will be responsible for commissioning the majority of health services in Manchester. This includes hospital and community services. Alongside this, the National Commissioning Board, through their Greater Manchester Area Team, will commission primary care and specialised services.
- **2.2** Over the last 9 months, the CCGs have been undergoing a national authorisation process to assess their capacity and capability to take on full commissioning responsibilities in April 2013. Over the summer, stakeholders were asked their opinion of the group and in September they submitted a range of key documents including commissioning plans.
- **2.3** In November 2012, the next stage of the process involved each CCG being visited by representatives of the NHS Commissioning Board to scrutinise the CCGs' plans and to discuss the documents submitted in September. The representatives also had to assure themselves that the CCGs could perform against 119 key lines of enquiry.
- 2.4 The visits were a great success with the visitors impressed by the achievements of the CCGs so far, and confident that their ambitions are supported by the people and plans they have in place. Very few lines of enquiry remain to be achieved for each CCG and this compares favourably with other CCGs in the North of England.
- **2.5** Formal notification of the authorisation of the CCGs will be received in February 2013.
