# HWB/13/02 Putting Patients First – NHS England Priorities for 2013/14 and 2014/15

The Director of Operations and Delivery, Greater Manchester Area Team, NHS England gave a presentation on NHS England business plan for 2013/14. The plan outlined the aims and priorities of NHS England, its operating model, how the priorities will be delivered and how outcomes for people will be improved. The presentation also outlined how the specific objectives and ambitions of NHS England will be delivered through the Greater Manchester Area Team.

On a national scale, NHS England will set the standards for commissioning healthcare services. It is responsible for the commissioning of primary care and some specialised and public health services and will also provide support to local clinical commissioning groups to arrange local services. Its long term priorities included supporting and strengthening the commissioning system, direct commissioning, and quality partnerships.
