 - Specialists Mobility Rehabilitation Centre (Preston)
 - Pennine Care Mental Health Service

Key Facts

- Royal British Legion Annual Survey of Veterans in 2014 found:
 - Those aged 16-34 more likely to report hear loss
 - Across all ages, more likely to report musculoskeletal problems
 - Significant increase in alcohol abuse in young early service leavers
- 560,000 veterans in the North West
- 66% will be aged over 65
- Average GP Practice will have a significant number of veterans

Health & Wellbeing Boards should have a robust JSNA covering the health needs of veterans with a focus on:

- Routine identification Targeted and intelligent use of data
- Provision of evidence based services
- Involvement of veterans and their families in the production of the JSNA
