Decision

To approve as a correct record the Minutes of the meeting held on 16 November 2010.

LP/12/02 Review of the Impact of Licensed Premises in Fallowfield and Withington

Consideration was given to the report of the Strategic Director of Neighbourhood Services, which detailed the results of an assessment undertaken to consider if there is a need for special policies in respect of Fallowfield and Withington.

Decision

1. The Committee determined that there is good evidence that crime and disorder or nuisance are happening and are caused by customers of licensed premises or that the risk of cumulative impact is imminent in all of the areas identified in this report, namely certain areas of Fallowfield, Wilmslow Road and Withington.
2. The Committee are satisfied that there is such good evidence that a special policy is necessary in all of those areas.
3. The Committee identified the boundaries of any or all of the areas to which any such special policy should apply – as identified in Appendix 1 of the report.
4. The Committee requested officers undertake a public consultation on the draft revision to the Council's Licensing Policy.
5. The Committee requested that Manchester Students Union and Manchester Students Homes be considered as part of any such consultation.
