2. Key Decisions

A key decision, as defined in the Council's Constitution is an executive decision, which is likely:

- To result in the Council incurring expenditure which is, or the making of savings which are, significant having regard to the Council's budget for the service or function to which the decision relates, or
- To be significant in terms of its effects on communities living or working in an area comprising two or more wards in the area of the city.

The Council Constitution defines 'significant' as being expenditure or savings (including the loss of income or capital receipts) in excess of £500k, providing that is not more than 10% of the gross operating expenditure for any budget heading in the in the Council's Revenue Budget Book, and subject to other defined exceptions.

Summary

At its meeting in 11 October 2016, the Committee made the following recommendation:

To note that the Strategic Lead Compliance and Enforcement would provide further information to members on housing enforcement; including a breakdown of the different notices served; and noisy parties including how many were resolved at what stage.

The table overleaf provides information on the number and type of housing enforcement notices served in the period January to August 2016

Noisy Parties

In the period January to August 2016, 104 reports relating to noisy parties were received. The majority of these were reported to the council retrospectively, rather than via Contact Manchester as they were happening, so the action taken was generally visits after the event. Outcomes in response to these reports were 31 noise abatement notices were issued and 60 warnings were given Residents have been encouraged to phone Contact Manchester as parties are occurring or if they see activity that suggests a party may be being set up so that proactive action can be taken. This is starting to happen.
