1.0 Background

1.1 We have reported to Scrutiny Committee on safety outside schools in the last two meetings and the focus of this report is the planned physical improvements to improve road safety at School Crossing Patrol locations and the resources we have made available to undertake this important programme of work.

1.2 As part of the 2016/17 and 2017/18 Capital budget proposals a total of £1.8m of City Council resources were approved by Council to create permanent highways improvements to improve road safety schemes near schools.

This was supplemented by a further additional Minor Works Growth Deal monies from Transport for Greater Manchester and from the 20mph allocation to fund a number of identified road safety measures near schools within various wards of Manchester that was approved by Executive in November 17th 2017.

- £530k TfGM Capital budget Growth Deal funding that was transferred from Traffic Management and Access Improvements, plus
- £650k transferred from 20mph schemes

1.3 We presented a report to the last Scrutiny Committee with a set of proposals for the phase 1 programme and further details on the selection criteria for phase 1 is included within this report. We are also proposing a set of criteria for how phase 2 schemes are assessed and prioritised.

1.4 Once final schemes are agreed for phase 2 we will have a better indication of the costs of the remaining schemes and whether to begin to develop a phase 3 programme.

2.0 Existing School Crossings

2.1 We agreed in the March 2017 budget to allocate capital funding to improve road safety outside schools and specifically at those locations where children cross the road to get to and from school supervised by a school crossing patrol.

2.2 All schools have been assessed by the Education department to identify their safety rating on a Red, Amber, Green basis. Capital funding was targeted to those locations that had been assessed by education as having the highest road safety risk – i.e. the greatest likelihood of an accident occurring. As such it was determined that those schools that have been assessed as having a Red or Amber road safety rating would be prioritised for highway improvements.

2.3 The road safety assessments carried out by Education are undertaken throughout the year and focus on a number of road safety attributes included recorded collisions. As such this data can quickly become superseded and as

part of any future prioritisation the most up-to-date data will be used in assessing a prioritisation of schemes.

3.0 Collision and Road Safety History outside Schools

3.1 The following tables shows all recorded collisions that have occurred outside schools across the city. This is based on the raw collision data and includes:-

- a. Recorded collisions (nationally the majority of accidents are damage only and are not recorded on the Police Database).
- b. Based on a 100m radius from the school gates – this means that accidents may be included on a major road or junction which may not be directly linked to the school or where the School Crossing Patrol Operates from. Further work is required to refine the accident data.
- c. 3 years collision data – between the hours of 8am and 4.30pm – Monday to Friday.

3.2 The data is from 01/01/15 until 28/02/2018 – between 0800 and 16:30 and within 100m radius of school entrance.

3.3 There may be overlap of data and some data may include main roads and junctions. Non-term time data is also included.

4.0 Information on how Phase 1 schemes have been prioritised (including how RAG ratings had been used).

4.1 The phase 01 prioritisation is established to:

- Ensure that the maximum number of locations can benefit from highway improvements within the initial budget.
- A small number of locations have been prioritised based on previous requests.

Based on this the first phase of the programme will move as many schools as possible to a 'Green' safety rating as quickly as possible. However, we know that much more improvement work is need to be done across the city which is why more schools will benefit from this programme in the future.

5.0 Detailed timescale for the implementation of improvements and funding projections for Phase 1 schemes

5.1 The table below sets out the programme for the delivery of the proposed improvements. Consultation will take place with statutory organisations and local members first and if agreed will then take place with local residents and schools. Depending on feedback from the consultation, design changes may be required and following further approval from local members, legal adverts will be posted (where necessary).

5.2 The anticipated delivery dates are as follows – as you will see the timeline is quite broad as some have more capital investment than other which means it will take longer to design and deliver.

6.0 Information on how schemes could be prioritised for phase 2 (including how RAG ratings had been used).

- 6.1 For phase two of the programme we will bring forward schemes looking firstly at the Red sites and then followed by the Amber sites. We will then further reprioritise the list with those locations that have the highest number of accidents (i.e. reds sites will be considered first followed by amber with the highest number of accidents). Highways and Education will work together to ensure that sites chosen are of the highest need, and local members will be closely consulted to ensure that the right schemes that fit into each category.
- 6.2 As mentioned earlier the most recent accident data will be refined to determine which sites should be prioritised in the second phase of work.

7.0 Programme for delivery of phase 2 schemes

- 7.1 Programme dates are subject to school calendar periods, where it is intended to carry out consultation during school term dates. Subject to the preferred selection method and resource available, the anticipated dates are as follows:-

8.0 Proposed Improvement Plan for each school site.

- 8.1 Plans of school crossings in respective wards will be shared with the appropriate ward members and feedback will be sought before the consultation begins

9.0 What considerations had been given to the finding of the Road Safety Task & Finish Group?

- 9.1 The Task & Finish Group investigated and subsequently reported on a wider set of issues to consider how we could improve road safety outside schools. A number of these points have already been reported back to the Committee in the previous 2 reports, but for information a summary is included below.
- 9.2 Following careful consideration of all of the evidence presented throughout the course of the Task and Finish Group the chair agreed the following recommendations to the Executive Member:
- 9.3 Recommendation 1: That the Executive Member for Environment update and refresh the school road safety guide.
- 9.4 Full details of this were included with the report that was presented to the Scrutiny Committee for their consideration last month.

9.5 Recommendation 2: That the Executive Member for Environment consider trial locations from the schools that had already volunteered as sites for temporary road closures and red routes outside schools.

9.6 Full details of this were included with the report that was presented to the Scrutiny Committee for their consideration last month.

9.7 Recommendation 3: That the Executive Member for Environment adopt the agreed preferred prioritisation methodology for physical road safety measures outside schools.

9.8 Details were included within the report that was presented to the Scrutiny Committee for their consideration last month and further information is included in point 10 above.

9.9 Recommendation 4: That the Executive Member for Environment continues to communicate with all schools' regarding the measures available to enforce parking violations and to facilitate schools own response to irresponsible driving and parking practices.

9.10 Full details of this were included with the report that was presented to the Scrutiny Committee for their consideration last month.
