1 Urgent business

2 Appeals

Members with a personal interest should declare that at the start of the item under consideration. If Members also have a prejudicial or disclosable pecuniary interest they must withdraw from the meeting during the consideration of the item.

4 The Council's Budget 2018-2020

The following procedure applies for this item:

- (i) The Committee will receive a statement by the Executive Member for Finance and Human Resources on the Executive's budget proposals and the key issues underlining the budget process;
- (ii) The Committee is invited to consider any issues arising from individual Business Plans that chairs of scrutiny committees wish to draw specific attention to;
- (iii) The Committee is invited to receive a Statement from the Deputy Leader regarding the Housing Revenue Account calculations and to consider any amendment proposed in relation to the Housing Revenue account 2017/18 to 2019/20;
- (iv) The Committee is invited to consider any amendments to the budget proposals; and
- (v) The Committee is invited to summarise its findings and formulate its recommendations to the Council meeting on 2 March 2018.

In connection to the above, the following documents were considered by Executive on 7 February 2017.

- (a) Capital Programme Monitoring Q3 2017/18.
- (b) Medium Term Financial Strategy 2017 -2020 noting that the Executive made a decision at its meeting on 7 February 2018 to agree all the recommendations but amend vii (a) to now recommend the Council to approve for 2018/19 an increase in the basic amount of Council Tax (i.e. the City.'s element of council tax) by 3.49% (including 1.5% for adult social care), with the use of a rebate from the Combined Authority and Business Rate Reserves to make up the Council Tax

income forgone as a consequence.

- (c) Growth and Neighbourhoods Budget and Business Planning 2018-2020.
- (d) Corporate Core Budget and Business Planning 2018-2020
- (e) Strategic Development Budget and Business Planning: 2018-2020
- (f) Children's Services and Education Budget and Business Planning: 2018-2020.
- (g) Manchester Health and Care Commissioning Joint Financial Plan 2018 – 2020 – noting that the Executive made a decision at its meeting on 7 February 2018 to agree to endorse the final proposals and recommend them for inclusion in the budget to Council
- (h) Adult Social Care Directorate Budget and Business Plan 2018 2020 (Part 1 – Health and Social Care, Part 2 – Homelessness).
- (i) The Manchester Local Care Organisation.
- (j) School Funding (Dedicated Schools Grant 2018/19) noting that the Executive made a decision at its meeting on 7 February 2018 to
 - 1. Note the Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG) funding in 2018/19;
 - 2. Note the statutory requirement for the Council to distribute school budgets by the end of February 2018; and
 - Delegate the decision on the final allocation of the Dedicated Schools Grant to schools based on the Council's local funding formula to the Director of Education and Skills and the City Treasurer in consultation with the Executive Member for Schools, Culture and Leisure and the Executive Member for Finance and Human Resources.
- (k) Housing Revenue Account 2018/19 to 2020/21
- (I) Capital Strategy and Budget 2018/19 to 2022/23
- (m) Treasury Management Strategy Statement and Borrowing Limits and Annual Investment Strategy 2018/19
- (n) Minutes of the proceedings of Overview and Scrutiny Committees relating to the budget for 2018-2020

Information about the Committee

Scrutiny Committees represent the interests of local people about important issues that affect them. They look at how the decisions, policies and services of the Council and other key public agencies impact on the city and its residents. Scrutiny Committees do not take decisions but can make recommendations to decisionmakers about how they are delivering the Manchester Strategy, an agreed vision for a better Manchester that is shared by public agencies across the city.

The Resources and Governance Scrutiny Committee areas of interest include finances, Council buildings, staffing, corporate and partnership governance as well as Council tax and benefits administration.

The Council wants to consult people as fully as possible before making decisions that affect them. Members of the public do not have a right to speak at meetings but may do so if invited by the Chair. If you have a special interest in an item on the agenda and want to speak, tell the Committee Officer, who will pass on your request to the Chair. Groups of people will usually be asked to nominate a spokesperson. The Council wants its meetings to be as open as possible but occasionally there will be some confidential business. Brief reasons for confidentiality will be shown on the agenda sheet.

The Council welcomes the filming, recording, public broadcast and use of social media to report on the Committee's meetings by members of the public.
