The Standards Committee is chaired by an Independent Member and comprises seven councillors and three independent members. The Committee deals with matters relating to the conduct of City and Parish Councillors and the promotion of ethical standards within the corporate governance framework.

The members of the Committee will constitute panels to make initial assessments of written allegations of breaches of the Members' Code of Conduct and determine whether to refer allegations to the Monitoring officer (an officer of the Council) for investigation, or to refer the allegation to the Standards Board for England for investigation. The panel may also decide that no action should be taken in respect of an allegation. Review Panels will also consider requests to review initial assessment decisions and the detailed reports on any matters referred by assessment panels for detailed investigation.

Members of the public do not have a right to speak at meetings, however, if you have a special interest in an item on the agenda and want to speak, tell the Committee Officer, who will pass on your request to the Chair. The law allows certain confidential items to be discussed in private and these will be taken at the end of the meeting at which point members of the public are asked to leave. The Council is concerned to ensure that its meetings are as open as possible and confidential business is kept to the strict minimum. Brief reasons for confidentiality are shown on the agenda sheet.
