Decision

ST/11/09 Amendments to the Localism Bill

A report was submitted by the City Solicitor to update the Committee on recent government amendments to the Localism Bill (now the Localism Act 2011), which will require authorities to adopt a code of conduct for elected and co-opted members that is consistent with the Nolan Principles of Public Life.

The report also detailed the requirement for arrangements to be made for the investigation of allegations made against Members and the taking of decisions on such allegations. The report advised of the requirements to maintain a register of Members interests and those relating to the disclosure of any pecuniary interests.

The report also detailed the sanctions that can be made for failing to comply with these requirements.

Decisions

To request the City Solicitor to report to a future meeting of the Committee with proposals for the implementation of the new ethical framework, including a revised Code of Conduct and associated protocols, and new arrangements for the investigation of, and the taking of decisions on, allegations made against members.
