Decision

ST/13/09 Annual Governance Statement

The Committee considered the 2012/13 Annual Governance Statement (AGS) which has been produced following the completion of the annual review of the Council's governance arrangements and systems of internal control.

The Performance and Business Planning Lead introduced the report. He explained that production of an AGS is a statutory requirement for all councils. The AGS evaluates governance systems in place from the previous year and includes steps to be taken to improve the following year. The Finance Scrutiny Committee and the Audit Committee have considered the draft AGS and made appropriate recommendations. After consideration by the Standards Committee the Annual Governance Statement will form part of the Council's final accounts that are reported to Audit Committee on 11 July 2013.

In discussion of paragraph 7.12 of the AGS, which reviewed compliance issues with information governance, the Committee suggested that additional wording was included to make it more explicit that the Council will comply with all relevant regulations and adopt best practice. The Performance and Business Planning Lead agreed to review this.

The Committee endorsed the AGS, and noted that it was clear from the document where the Standards Committee fitted into the governance structures of the Council.
