The two additional conditions, as agreed between the parties, are as follows:

1. Notices shall be prominently displayed at the shop exit and the night pay window requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and leave the area quietly and not congregate in the area.
2. The premises shall display prominent signage indicating at any point of sale including the night pay window that it is an offence to buy or attempt to buy alcohol for a person who is under 18 and for a person under the age of 18 to buy or attempt to buy alcohol.
