1. Additional comments

Manchester Civic Society objected to the proposed development as it was originally submitted. The Society raised the following issues;

- They consider the submission to be lacking in detail for a full application
- They are concerned that the extensions will have a negative impact on the area.
- The building should be cherished.
- The symmetry of the building is lost.
- There will be a loss of open space.
- a loss of landscaping/amenity space
- It will set a negative precedent for the area.
- It will have a negative impact on the local community
- It is an excessive overdevelopment of the site not only in terms of footprint but volume
- It will encourage a transient population rather than permanent residency.

2. Director of Planning

The comments of Manchester Civic Society relate to the original proposal prior to the revised drawings being received. All matters raised are dealt with within the main body of the report. The recommendation remains one of approve.
