Due to another large scale disorder at another premises in the city centre all the police officers were already engaged dealing with that when the calls came in for this incident so it was 0355 hours when the first police officers arrived at the location.

By this time the fighting and disorder had stopped so the officers spoke to the staff at the front door and as a result of this conversation they updated that on arrival all the fighting had stopped and that all the suspects had dispersed and that nobody was reporting anything regarding injuries.

A male was later located at the Manchester Royal Infirmary with a head injury and he informed that officers that he had been hit on the head by a glass bottle that had been thrown inside the premises during the incident. He had been taken to the hospital by an ambulance.

All the above information was placed on the same police log 601-19092021 but several other calls came in on different police logs and these were as follows:

At 0340 hours GMP received a call from staff at the premises who stated that there were 10-15 people fighting inside the bar and tables were being thrown around stated that there were some people bleeding and one male had a head injury but nobody was unconscious. said that was phoning an ambulance.

At 0343 hours a call came in from a person who stated that fighting was ongoing and someone was unconscious and there were 15-20 people involved.

At 0349 hours a call came in from a staff member who shouted that they needed the police and there was the sound of a car alarm and someone shouting "Everybody get inside quick"

At 0412 hours a call came in from staff at the premises who said that the males involved in the earlier incident had returned and were being aggressive outside claiming that they had lost a phone inside the premises but that the phone had already been returned. Whilst the caller was on the call the males calmed down and left the location.

As a result of this incident a crime report for Section 18 Wounding and a crime report for Affray have been submitted and enquiries to trace the offenders are ongoing.

I now submit these incident reports and crime reports as exhibits AEI/1, AEI/2, AEI/3, AEI/4, AEI/5, AEI/6 and AEI/7 and these can be found at pages 4-27 of the bundle.

There is CCTV coverage of all this incident and there is a CCTV log provided as part of this bundle which highlights key moments of the incident and can be found at pages 28-35 of the bundle but some of the main points that can be made from the footage and subsequent enquiries are as follows:

The group of males who instigated this incident inside the premises and continued fighting outside the premises were initially refused entry to the premises.

They were later allowed entry to the premises after discussions bet6ween staff members but their ID was not scanned onto the Clubscan system which is in breach of condition 12 at Annex 3 of the Premises Licence. Instead their ID was taken off them but doesn't appear to have been looked at and is then kept by the staff until it is later returned to them.

The fight inside the premises and the subsequent fight outside the premises involving the group of males and nearly all the door staff is best described by viewing the CCTV footage but it is no exaggeration to say that it was some of the worst disorder linked to a licensed premises that I have seen in my 11 years as a police licensing officer. The fact that security barriers are wielded and used like clubs and thrown across a main road is truly shocking. Not only that but bottles are thrown, cars are indiscriminately damaged and a make shift club is produced at one point.

Then when police arrive on scene and find that everything had died down they speak to staff at the door of the premises and they are told that there has been a fight inside and then outside and that some cars were damaged but nobody from the premises identifies any of the males who are still standing outside the premises as being responsible. This is shown by the fact my colleagues make their way back to their vehicles and notify control that the offenders have left the location and that nobody is making themselves known to them as a victim.

This is extremely concerning as it shows that the premises have not assisted GMP in apprehending the offenders who were still at the location. This conversation was captured on the body worn video of one of the officers who attended.

I now submit this CCTV and body worn video footage as exhibit AEI/8.

Interim Steps Hearing

On Monday 20th September 2021 PC McIntosh applied for a Summary Review of the Premises Licence on the grounds that the Premises were associated with Serious Crime and Serious Disorder. The certificate was signed by Superintendent Fraser.

The Interim Steps hearing took place on Wednesday 22nd September 2021 at Manchester Town Hall where GMP outlined our concerns regarding the premises and outlined the CCTV footage that we had available to the committee. We asked the committee to suspend the Premises Licence pending the outcome of the full review hearing and, after deliberation; the committee took the decision to suspend the Premises Licence pending the full review hearing on Monday 18th October 2021.

Conclusion


Having had chance to review this incident and, after having a discussion with my GMP colleagues, we are firmly of the opinion that this premises has seriously undermined the licensing objectives of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Public Safety.

Also because of the way that the offenders were allowed entry without being scanned in and because the staff did not identify the offenders to the police who attended GMP have no confidence with the operators of these premises and we believe that to allow them to operate as a licensed premises will cause more violent incidents to occur and more customers and staff to be injured and placed in danger.

GMP do not believe that the addition of further conditions, removal of DPS, a reduction in hours or a period of suspension would address these concerns.

So GMP would ask the committee to Revoke the Premises Licence.

OUTSIDE BEFORE THE INITIAL FIGHTING BEGAN INSIDE THE PREMISES: <u>D17 FRONT ENTRANCE / D13 QUEEN STREET (00:15 – 00:47)</u>
D13 Queen Street – Queuing barriers (00:15-00:21)
00:15:18 PARTY X arrive (which consists of at this time) and they approach Head of Security one of the males greets him with a handshake.
00:15:38 a male customer in the smoking comes into view of the camera and a member of PARTY X acknowledges him and another member goes and speaks with him shortly after.
arrives and appears to engage the males in conversation, one of the males' points at his phone and moves out of shot.
00:17:00 another one of the males greets a male in the smoking area wearing a white t-shirt.
00:17:03 moves out of view of the camera.
oo:18:03 both return onto the screen and eaves the barriered area to speak with PARTY X.





CONDITION BREACH: Annex 3, 12. An ID Clubscan or equivalent (to the same standard) shall be in operation at the premises. D28 Front Door - Knife arch top of the stairs (club scan/door covered by a curtain) (00:40 - 00:44)

00:40:30 – Two males walk around the knife arch; security appears to direct him back around. Male shows his arm to the security, and he is allowed to proceed down the stairs with another male. **CONDITION BREACH**

00:41:43 – PARTY X comes through the knife arch and are patted down and given wrist bands.

00:42:48 – holding a backpack walks around the knife arch and stands in the foyer area.

00:24:56 – walks around the knife arch and waits in the foyer area.

00:43:46 – the two aforementioned proceed downstairs

condition breach: Annex 3, 23. There shall be a metal detecting search arch, comprising of a fixed structure at the entrance which must be passed through, installed at the premises and operated at such times as agreed with the GMP. Every patron entering the premises to use the licensing facilities shall pass through the metal detecting search arch unless otherwise agreed with GMP. Any customers who refuse to pass through the metal detecting search arch will not be allowed entry to the premises.

D11 Tables 5&6 VIP Area (03:35-03:34)

PARTY X can be seen at the top of the screen. Staff can be seen cleaning tables and security personnel appear to be communicating with occupied tables within this area.

03:35:57 One male punched the other to the face, the victim falls to the floor. NB and the security staff are at this location and start trying to split people up.

03:36:14 one member of PARTY X appears to pick something up from the table and puts the item down the front of his trousers. The members can be seen removing ice buckets electronic shisha from the area.

03:38:58 fighting with PARTY X moves into the view of this camera, bar staff can be seen fleeing from behind the bar.

Staff and customers inc members of PARTY X can be seen walking into the view of this camera but nothing further of note.

D24 Fire Exit (03:38-03:43)

03:38:54 8 customers start exiting via the fire escape, followed by three members of staff and a customer.

03:42:58 3 further customers leave via this exit.

Despite being told that some of the customers involved in the internal fighting were removed from the premises vis the rear of the building there is no evidence of this. The only thing this camera shows is staff and some customers using this exit to leave the premises, at no point are any security staff seen in this area.

OUTSIDE THE PREMISES AFTER THE FIGHTING INSIDE THE VENUE <u>D13 QUEEN STREET / D17 FRONT ENTERANCE / D16 ENTRANCE DOOR (03:41 – 04:36)</u>

D13 Queen Street – Queue Barriers (03:41)

03:41:45 PARTY X are ejected from the premises on to Queen Street, they can be seen throwing barriers, poles and one member of the group has hold of a rope used on the poles. Security staff can also be seen throwing and holing poles.

D17 Front Entrance - Queen Street, towards Deansgate (03:41 - 03:42)

03:41:56 member ejected with PARTY X can be seen hitting a parked car windscreen with a barrier rope, windscreen cracks, he then throws the rope at the security team.

03:42:01 another member of PARTY X appears to have pulled a large bottle from his trousers, and he proceeds to hit another parked car windscreen, liquid can be seen with the impact and the car alarm appears to go off has the cars hazard lights start flashing. This male then proceeds to the rear of the first car that had its windscreen damage, and he hits the rears window.

03:42:20 something appears to have been thrown at the security team as bits can be seen on the camera. After this the security team can be seen running towards PARTY X with barrier poles and ropes. One member of staff can be seen throwing a pole onto Deansgate. Another

member of security staff can be seen running across Deansgate and hits someone with a pole on the road, he proceeds onto the pavement, and he can be seen hitting the person a further two times. This then moves off screen towards Peter Street. The other half of PARTY X walks up Deansgate towards John Rylands Library and security staff follow. PARTY X return from the direction of Peter Street and a further outbreak of fighting with the security staff breaks out and goes off screen.

D13 Queen Street – Queue Barriers (03:44 – 03:47) 03:44:38 returns to the door of the premises where appears to show his frustration towards with animated hand gestures towards throwing a rope on the floor.

D16 Entrance Door—view directly outside the front door (03:47)

03:47:37 Something containing liquid is thrown at the security staff and a member of the public/customer on this camera fragment's possibly of a broken bottle are also seen landing on the floor.

D17 Front Entrance - view Queen Street towards Deansgate (03:47)

03:47:37 something, possibly a bottle containing liquid as seen in D13/D16 from in the square outside Centurion House towards the premises fighting breaks out once again.

D16 Entrance Door – view directly outside the front door (03:47)

The security team then also cross Queens Street and stand on the steps outside Starbucks.

When the premises operates after midnight then SIA registered door staff shall be employed at the premises on the ratio of 1:100 from opening until 30 minutes after the premises closes to ensure persons arriving and leaving do so without causing incidents of disorder or public nuisance. On all other days the need for door staff shall be risk assessed by the Designated Premises Supervisor and employed when the risk assessment deems it necessary or when informed by Greater Manchester Police of the need for door staff. When employed at the premises door staff shall wear Hi Viz clothing both inside and outside the premises.

Annex 3, Condition 18

All SIA registered staff working at the premises shall wear high visibility vest/ tabard/ armband/ recognised uniform whilst the premises is in operation so they can be readily identified.

I am giving this certificate because I am of the opinion that other procedures under the Licensing Act are inappropriate in this case, because

The standard review of the premises licence under section 51 Licensing Act 2003 is inappropriate due to length of time a standard review would take, there are serious concerns as to the serious nature of the incident which require immediate resolution. Greater Manchester Police believe that serious crime and serious disorder has occurred at the premises.

Greater Manchester Police (GMP) will say that the premises are associated with serious crime and serious disorder. Serious crime is defined within the statutory guidance as per section 81(3)(a) and (b) of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000, which states that the conduct constitutes an offence for which a person 21 years of age or over with no previous convictions could reasonably be expected to be sentenced to imprisonment for 3 years or more. Therefore due to the serious crime and serious disorder this has taken place at the premises, GMP feel that it is necessary for an expedited review to take place.

The premises are situated on 2 Queen Street, Manchester City Centre and the premises licence was issued on 22/07/2014. The Premises Licence Holder (PLH) is OOTF LTD and the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) is Leonard Cunningham.

During the morning of Sunday 19th September 2021, customers from two separate tables in the VIP area started fighting, Door staff moved the customers into the main bar area where they continued to fight. Bar furniture was thrown by customers and metal barrier poles.



During the melee a customer was knocked unconscious, resulting in the male having to be taken to hospital. Innocent customers and staff can be seen running away in fear from the groups fighting.


This investigation is in its early stages and there will no doubt be more information uncovered over the coming weeks but what is clear is that serious disorder and serious crimes have occurred at the premise.

The powers under sections 53A to 53C of the 2003 Act, are aimed at tackling serious crime and serious disorder.

The powers contained under section 53A of the Licensing Act 2003 are necessary and proportionate in light of the association that the premises has to serious crime and serious disorder.

In the interim Greater Manchester Police would request that the Licensing Authority consider suspension of the Premises Licence until the full review is heard before the committee. Serious Crime and serious disorder has occurred at the premises and until the Licensing Committee hear the full review and all the evidence that will be disclosed, to allow the premises to continue to operate as a licensed premises gives concerns that further crime will occur and place customers and staff in danger.. Greater Manchester Police will say that the licensing objectives of the prevention of crime and disorder can only be promoted if the premises licence was suspended until the final determination of the summary review application.

The standard review of the premises licence under section 51 Licensing Act 2003 is inappropriate due to length of time a standard review would take, there are serious concerns in relation to the violence and serious disorder at the premises.
