I am Police Constable 17659 Isherwood of the Greater Manchester Police, Licensing Officer for the City of Manchester Division, currently based in the Licensing Team at Manchester Town Hall Extension.

Part of my remit as licensing officer is to oversee all of the licensed premises on the City of Manchester Division. The objective of the role is to promote and maintain the 4 licensing objectives at licensed premises, those being the Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Public Safety, Prevention of Public Nuisance and the Protection of Children from Harm.

Cirque le Soir

The premises are situated in St John's House on Queen Street in the Deansgate area of Manchester City centre. The premises licence was issued on 22/07/2014. The Premises Licence Holder (PLH) is OOTF Ltd and the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) is Leonard Cunningham who has held this position since August 2019. The premises itself has been known previously as The Press Club and later as Toy Box under previous ownerships and during these previous guises it has been subject to Summary Review proceedings in October 2016 as The Press Club and in January 2019 as Toy Box following incidents of extreme violence and disorder. So unfortunately the premises has a history of issues under different operators and seems to attract an unsavoury element whatever style of operation it adopts. It opened as Cirque le Soir in August 2019.

Incident

At 0339 hours on Sunday 19th September 2021 GMP were contacted by [REDACTED] on a mobile phone and the sounds of a large disturbance could be heard in the background but the caller did not say anything other than Hello.

A minute later another call came inform [REDACTED] who stated that there were 12 people fighting at Cirque Club and that they were assaulting the staff and each other. [REDACTED] went on to say that one male had been knocked out and had been unconscious for about 2 minutes and was now vomiting.

A further call came in at 0346 from staff at the premises who informed us that it was still kicking off and that the male who had been unconscious was now conscious and had a cut to his lip. [REDACTED] stated that there were 15-20 people fighting outside the premises and that some of them had head injuries and were covered in blood. The call continued and it was reported that bottles were being thrown.

By 0348 hours the caller had estimated that between 40-50 people were now fighting outside the premises and that threats to shoot people had been made. It was reported that there was a male with a large hole in his head who was insisting on leaving.

Due to another large scale disorder at another premises in the city centre all the police officers were already engaged dealing with that when the calls came in for this incident so it was 0355 hours when the first police officers arrived at the location.

By this time the fighting and disorder had stopped so the officers spoke to the staff at the front door and as a result of this conversation they updated that on arrival all the fighting had stopped and that all the suspects had dispersed and that nobody was reporting anything regarding injuries.

A male was later located at the Manchester Royal Infirmary with a head injury and he informed that officers that he had been hit on the head by a glass bottle that had been thrown inside the premises during the incident. He had been taken to the hospital by an ambulance.

All the above information was placed on the same police log 601-19092021 but several other calls came in on different police logs and these were as follows:

At 0340 hours GMP received a call from staff at the premises who stated that there were 10-15 people fighting inside the bar and tables were being thrown around. [REDACTED] stated that there were some people bleeding and one male had a head injury but nobody was unconscious. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] was phoning an ambulance.

At 0343 hours a call came in from a person who stated that fighting was ongoing and someone was unconscious and there were 15-20 people involved.

At 0349 hours a call came in from a staff member who shouted that they needed the police and there was the sound of a car alarm and someone shouting "Everybody get inside quick"

At 0412 hours a call came in from staff at the premises who said that the males involved in the earlier incident had returned and were being aggressive outside claiming that they had lost a phone inside the premises but that the phone had already been returned. Whilst the caller was on the call the males calmed down and left the location.

As a result of this incident a crime report for Section 18 Wounding and a crime report for Affray have been submitted and enquiries to trace the offenders are ongoing.

I now submit these incident reports and crime reports as exhibits AEI/1, AEI/2, AEI/3, AEI/4, AEI/5, AEI/6 and AEI/7 and these can be found at pages 4-27 of the bundle.

There is CCTV coverage of all this incident and there is a CCTV log provided as part of this bundle which highlights key moments of the incident and can be found at pages 28-35 of the bundle but some of the main points that can be made from the footage and subsequent enquiries are as follows:

The group of males who instigated this incident inside the premises and continued fighting outside the premises were initially refused entry to the premises.

They were later allowed entry to the premises after discussions between staff members but their ID was not scanned onto the Clubscan system which is in breach of condition 12 at Annex 3 of the Premises Licence. Instead their ID was taken off them but doesn't appear to have been looked at and is then kept by the staff until it is later returned to them.

The fight inside the premises and the subsequent fight outside the premises involving the group of males and nearly all the door staff is best described by viewing the CCTV footage but it is no exaggeration to say that it was some of the worst disorder linked to a licensed premises that I have seen in my 11 years as a police licensing officer. The fact that security barriers are wielded and used like clubs and thrown across a main road is truly shocking. Not only that but bottles are thrown, cars are indiscriminately damaged and a make shift club is produced at one point.

Then when police arrive on scene and find that everything had died down they speak to staff at the door of the premises and they are told that there has been a fight inside and then outside and that some cars were damaged but nobody from the premises identifies any of the males who are still standing outside the premises as being responsible. This is shown by the fact my colleagues make their way back to their vehicles and notify control that the offenders have left the location and that nobody is making themselves known to them as a victim.

This is extremely concerning as it shows that the premises have not assisted GMP in apprehending the offenders who were still at the location. This conversation was captured on the body worn video of one of the officers who attended.

I now submit this CCTV and body worn video footage as exhibit AEI/8.

Interim Steps Hearing

On Monday 20th September 2021 PC McIntosh applied for a Summary Review of the Premises Licence on the grounds that the Premises were associated with Serious Crime and Serious Disorder. The certificate was signed by Superintendent Fraser.

The Interim Steps hearing took place on Wednesday 22nd September 2021 at Manchester Town Hall where GMP outlined our concerns regarding the premises and outlined the CCTV footage that we had available to the committee. We asked the committee to suspend the Premises Licence pending the outcome of the full review hearing and, after deliberation; the committee took the decision to suspend the Premises Licence pending the full review hearing on Monday 18th October 2021.

Conclusion

Having had chance to review this incident and, after having a discussion with my GMP colleagues, we are firmly of the opinion that this premises has seriously undermined the licensing objectives of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Public Safety.

Also because of the way that the offenders were allowed entry without being scanned in and because the staff did not identify the offenders to the police who attended GMP have no confidence with the operators of these premises and we believe that to allow them to operate as a licensed premises will cause more violent incidents to occur and more customers and staff to be injured and placed in danger.

GMP do not believe that the addition of further conditions, removal of DPS, a reduction in hours or a period of suspension would address these concerns.

So GMP would ask the committee to Revoke the Premises Licence.

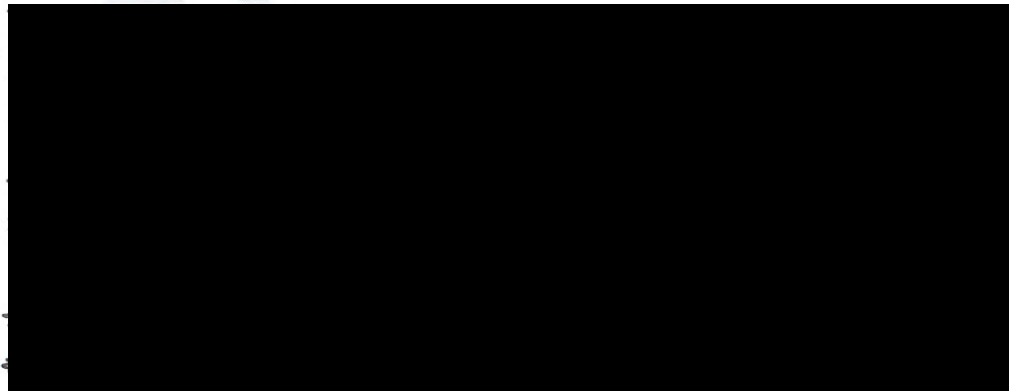

D13 Queen Street – Queuing barriers (00:15-00:21)

00:15:18 PARTY X arrive (which consists of [REDACTED] at this time) and they approach [REDACTED] Head of Security one of the males greets him with a handshake.

00:15:38 a male customer in the smoking comes into view of the camera and a member of PARTY X acknowledges him and another member goes and speaks with him shortly after.

00:16:07 [REDACTED] arrives and appears to engage the males in conversation, one of the males' points at his phone and [REDACTED] moves out of shot.

00:17:00 another one of the males greets a male in the smoking area wearing a white t-shirt.

00:17:03 [REDACTED] moves out of view of the camera.

00:18:03 both [REDACTED] return onto the screen and [REDACTED] leaves the barriered area to speak with PARTY X.

00:18:32 [REDACTED] has a conversation with [REDACTED] on two occasions during this conversation [REDACTED] looks in the direction of PARTY X.

00:19:31 [REDACTED] is continuing to have a conversation with PARTY X one of the males starts trying to show [REDACTED] his phone.

00:20:38 a [REDACTED] of the venue. [REDACTED] get out of the vehicle and greet PARTY X with a further [REDACTED] joining by walking down Queen Street towards Deansgate. Another [REDACTED] appear to join the group on foot from the direction of Deansgate.

D17 Front Entrance - Queen Street, towards Deansgate (00:20-00:26)

00:20:38 [REDACTED], as per D13 of people that joins PARTY X.

D13 Queen Street – Queuing barriers (00:21)

00:21:34 [REDACTED] appears to end the conversation [REDACTED] with PARTY X and returns to the barriered area, [REDACTED] continues to speak with PARTY X and [REDACTED] in the smoking area.

D17 Front Entrance - Queen Street, towards Deansgate (00:26)

00:26:13 PARTY X can be seen leaving on foot on Deansgate towards John Rylands Library, they appear to stop near to some construction fencing.

D13 Queen Street – Queuing barriers (00:26 - 00:29)

00:26:18 PARTY X leave this area out of view of this camera.

00:27:05 [REDACTED] comes into the camera view from the premises and approaches [REDACTED] and has a conversation, [REDACTED] also joins in this conversation. [REDACTED] walks out of the view of the camera at 00:27:30.

00:29:15 [REDACTED] is within the barrier area and approaches [REDACTED], they appear to start a conversation and [REDACTED] hand and gestures in the direction of where PARTY X are, along with [REDACTED] then leaves the area towards Deansgate.

D17 Front Entrance - Queen Street, towards Deansgate (00:29-00:32)

00:29:20 PARTY X can be seen on Deansgate walking back in the direction of Queen Street. 00:29:39 two members of PARTY X meet [REDACTED] near to the trees outside Starbucks, they shake hands with [REDACTED] and they appear to have a conversation and another two members of PARTY X join them.

00:31:39 [REDACTED] can be seen heading back towards the premises.

D13 Queen Street – Queuing barriers (00:31-00:32)

00:31:46 [REDACTED] returns to the premises and again speaks with [REDACTED] has a conversation until 00:32:50 and [REDACTED] returns to the direction of Deansgate.

D17 Front Entrance - Queen Street, towards Deansgate (00:32-00:34)

00:32:51 [REDACTED] walks back towards Deansgate and PARTY X, to member now stood next to the bus stop on Deansgate.

00:33:16 [REDACTED] can be seen walking back to the premises, PARTY X walk on Deansgate towards John Rylands Library and stand with the rest of PARTY X next to the construction fencing.

00:34:18 PARTY X can be seen walking back towards the premises. (9 males)

D13 Queen Street – Queuing barriers (00:33- 00:41)

00:33:22 [REDACTED] returns from the direction of Deansgate and returns to the barriered area, talks to [REDACTED] and moves out of shot towards the entrance of the premises.

00:34:40 PARTY X returns and joins the queuing barriers.

00:35:12 [REDACTED] can be seen engaging with PARTY X in the queuing area, [REDACTED] seen shaking [REDACTED] head and pressing [REDACTED] hands together (in praying position) while in conversation with the group.

00:36:07 [REDACTED] appears to be returning to the barriered area when the member of staff in the [REDACTED] appears to say something to [REDACTED] returns to the Queen Street area while shaking his head. [REDACTED] returns to talk to PARTY X

00:37:05 [REDACTED] approaches [REDACTED] then returns to the barriered area with [REDACTED] who grabs [REDACTED] arm and they both walk just out of shot having a conversation. [REDACTED] starts to talk with PARTY X. [REDACTED] walk back into shot at

00:37:27 [REDACTED] position on Queen Street (outside of the barriered area).

00:38:24 [REDACTED] conversation with PARTY X and returns to the barriered area, [REDACTED] both walk out of shot towards the premises entrance. They return at 00:39:20, they both return to PARTY X. [REDACTED] shakes the hand of the first member of PARTY X in the queue.

00:40:49 [REDACTED] appears to ask [REDACTED] to deal with the entry of PARTY X, [REDACTED] approaches and 9 males are let into the premises, 00:41:11 passport and driving licenses are handed over by one member of PARTY X to [REDACTED] Although we are aware that these ID's where not put through the 'club scan' none of them appear to be checked against the people entering.

CONDITION BREACH: Annex 3, 12. An ID Clubscan or equivalent (to the same standard) shall be in operation at the premises. All customers' identification documents shall be checked via the system before being allowed access to the premises. Any person refusing to comply shall be refused access to the premises.

D28 FRONT DOOR / D11 TABLES 5&6 VIP / D5 TABLE 22 / D25 BAR AREA / D5 BAR / D24 FIRE EXIT (00:40 – 03:42)

D28 Front Door – Knife arch top of the stairs (club scan/door covered by a curtain) (00:40 – 00:44)

00:40:30 – Two males walk around the knife arch; security appears to direct him back around. Male shows his arm to the security, and he is allowed to proceed down the stairs with another male. **CONDITION BREACH**

00:41:43 – PARTY X comes through the knife arch and are patted down and given wrist bands.

00:42:48 – [REDACTED] holding a backpack walks around the knife arch and stands in the foyer area.

00:24:56 – [REDACTED] walks around the knife arch and waits in the foyer area.

00:43:46 – the two aforementioned [REDACTED] proceed downstairs

CONDITION BREACH: Annex 3, 23. There shall be a metal detecting search arch, comprising of a fixed structure at the entrance which must be passed through, installed at the premises and operated at such times as agreed with the GMP. Every patron entering the premises to use the licensing facilities shall pass through the metal detecting search arch unless otherwise agreed with GMP. Any customers who refuse to pass through the metal detecting search arch will not be allowed entry to the premises.

D11 Tables 5&6 VIP Area (03:35-03:34)

PARTY X can be seen at the top of the screen. Staff can be seen cleaning tables and security personnel appear to be communicating with occupied tables within this area.

03:35:57 One male punched the other to the face, the victim falls to the floor. NB and the security staff are at this location and start trying to split people up.

03:36:14 one member of PARTY X appears to pick something up from the table and puts the item down the front of his trousers. [REDACTED] members can be seen removing ice buckets electronic shisha from the area.

D5 Table 22 – Stage area (03:36-03:38) (security wearing body camera 03:35:35)

03:36:14 male seen with rope pole; member of security removes the pole from him

03:37:55 security can be seen trying to manage the fight with this area, PARTY X start trying to fight with the security team within view of this camera, 03:38:11 a small table appears to have been thrown at the security.

D25 Bar area (03:38)

03:38:04 security seen trying to remove a member of PARTY X.

D5 Table 22 – Stage area (03:38)

03:38:18 the small table is picked up by a member of PARTY X and is thrown at security.

03:38:21 a table is picked up by a member of PARTY X but is put back down.

D25 Bar area (03:38-03:44)

03:38:17 a small table is thrown at security staff.

03:38:38 a male with a [REDACTED] seen approaching the member of PARTY X being restrained by the security staff and words are exchanged which appears to heat up the situation. The male with the [REDACTED] keeps coming back and at 03:38:52 he punches the member of PARTY X to the face he then then restrained by a member of the security team.

03:39:02 the member of PARTY X that is being restrained makes his way round to the male in [REDACTED] he punches a male in [REDACTED] to the face. This male falls to the floor and appears to be unconscious. A member of staff and a customer pull this male out of the way of the melee the security continue to try and separate the people fighting.

03:42:59 male who had been knock unconscious seen walking with a bottle of water, he is approached by staff and is sat down, member off staff can be seen [REDACTED] and appears to be checking the male's head.

03:44:25 the seated male starts vomiting, ice buckets are brought by staff for the male to be sick into. Two staff members tend to the male's face and the back of his head.

D5 Bar (03:35-03:39)

Staff can be seen cleaning the bar area, security moving customers away from this area barring two [REDACTED] appear to know the staff.

03:35:52 all people in this area start looking in the same direction, open mouthed / covering mouth customer can be seen a minute later rushing around.

03:37:13 bar staff start moving the tills from the location on the bar while cleaning and removing all the bottles from the back of the bar into the fridges.

03:38:58 fighting with PARTY X moves into the view of this camera, bar staff can be seen fleeing from behind the bar.

Staff and customers inc members of PARTY X can be seen walking into the view of this camera but nothing further of note.

D24 Fire Exit (03:38-03:43)

03:38:54 8 customers start exiting via the fire escape, followed by three members of staff and a customer.

03:42:58 3 further customers leave via this exit.

Despite being told that some of the customers involved in the internal fighting were removed from the premises via the rear of the building there is no evidence of this. The only thing this camera shows is staff and some customers using this exit to leave the premises, at no point are any security staff seen in this area.

OUTSIDE THE PREMISES AFTER THE FIGHTING INSIDE THE VENUE

D13 QUEEN STREET / D17 FRONT ENTRANCE / D16 ENTRANCE DOOR (03:41 – 04:36)

D13 Queen Street – Queue Barriers (03:41)

03:41:45 PARTY X are ejected from the premises on to Queen Street, they can be seen throwing barriers, poles and one member of the group has hold of a rope used on the poles. Security staff can also be seen throwing and holing poles.

D17 Front Entrance - Queen Street, towards Deansgate (03:41 – 03:42)

03:41:56 member ejected with PARTY X can be seen hitting a parked car windscreen with a barrier rope, windscreen cracks, he then throws the rope at the security team.

03:42:01 another member of PARTY X appears to have pulled a large bottle from his trousers, and he proceeds to hit another parked car windscreen, liquid can be seen with the impact and the car alarm appears to go off as the cars hazard lights start flashing. This male then proceeds to the rear of the first car that had its windscreen damage, and he hits the rears window.

03:42:20 something appears to have been thrown at the security team as bits can be seen on the camera. After this the security team can be seen running towards PARTY X with barrier poles and ropes. One member of staff can be seen throwing a pole onto Deansgate. Another

member of security staff can be seen running across Deansgate and hits someone with a pole on the road, he proceeds onto the pavement, and he can be seen hitting the person a further two times. This then moves off screen towards Peter Street. The other half of PARTY X walks up Deansgate towards John Rylands Library and security staff follow. PARTY X return from the direction of Peter Street and a further outbreak of fighting with the security staff breaks out and goes off screen.

D13 Queen Street – Queue Barriers (03:44 – 03:47)

03:44:38 [REDACTED] returns to the door of the premises where [REDACTED] appears to show his frustration towards [REDACTED] with animated hand gestures towards [REDACTED] and throwing a rope on the floor.

03:45:37 a member of the security team can be seen removing [REDACTED] and then heads towards Deansgate off camera.

03:47:37 Something containing liquid is thrown at the security staff and a member of the public/customer runs off down Queen Street a member of the security staff is seen briefly trying to remove the base of a pole.

D16 Entrance Door– view directly outside the front door (03:47)

03:47:37 Something containing liquid is thrown at the security staff and a member of the public/customer on this camera fragment's possibly of a broken bottle are also seen landing on the floor.

D17 Front Entrance – view Queen Street towards Deansgate (03:47)

03:47:37 something, possibly a bottle containing liquid as seen in D13/D16 from in the square outside Centurion House towards the premises fighting breaks out once again.

D16 Entrance Door – view directly outside the front door (03:47)

03:48:06 the additional member of security appears to be walking some of Cirque security staff back to the premises from the direction of Deansgate he then proceeds towards Starbucks where PARTY X are located. The security team then also cross Queens Street and stand on the steps outside Starbucks.

D13 Queen Street – Queue Barriers (03:48 – 03:49)

03:48:12 a member of the public/ customer throws something in the direction of PARTY X security and the [REDACTED] can be seen gesturing for him not to do this.

03:49:22 all security staff and male [REDACTED] return to the venue from being stood on the opposite side of Queen Street, PARTY X remain outside Starbucks.

D16 Entrance Door – view directly outside the front door (03:49)

03:49:51 from this camera when the member of Cirque security approaches the additional member security his colleague can be seen trying to stop him by grabbing his [REDACTED]

D13 Queen Street – Queue Barriers (03:49 – 03:52)

03:49:59 three members of PARTY X approach the security team and start talking to one member of staff (this member of staff [REDACTED] situation)

03:51:49 a member of Cirque security team moves closer to the member of staff talking to PARTY X, a member of PARTY X then punches him in the face, and everyone moves off screen.

D16 Entrance Door – view directly outside the front door (03:52)

03:52:28 a member of PARTY X can be seen on standing on the wall of Starbucks he then throws something at the security team, when it hits the floor, it appears to be some sort of large aerosol can. A member of the public / customer can be seen picking up and throwing a parasol base from Starbucks outside seating area.

D13 Queen Street – Queue Barriers (03:52)

03:52:59 [REDACTED] has moved away from the main people of PARTY X to talk to someone else out of view of this camera (D17 show these as other members of PARTY X). Another male appears and approaches Cirque's security team holding some sort of long implement which [REDACTED] He looks like he intends to hit the security team with this item. The additional security turns round and removes this item from him and throws it to the floor.

After this (03:52) everything appears to have calmed down PARTY X remain outside the premises talking with the security team until 04:17 with no further issues.

D17 Front Entrance – view Queen Street towards Deansgate (03:56 – 04:36)

03:56:56 GMP arrive and park on Deansgate, then walk over to the venue, speak with people outside the venue and leave at 04:00:06

04:36:27 Male who was knocked unconscious inside the venue can be seen leaving the venue with the paramedics.

END OF CCTV FOOTAGE REVIEWED

OTHER CONDITION BREACHES NOTED:

Annex 3, Condition 2

When the premises operates after midnight then SIA registered door staff shall be employed at the premises on the ratio of 1:100 from opening until 30 minutes after the premises closes to ensure persons arriving and leaving do so without causing incidents of disorder or public nuisance. On all other days the need for door staff shall be risk assessed by the Designated Premises Supervisor and employed when the risk assessment deems it necessary or when informed by Greater Manchester Police of the need for door staff. When employed at the premises door staff shall wear Hi Viz clothing both inside and outside the premises.

Therefore due to the serious crime and serious disorder this has taken place at the premises, GMP feel that it is necessary for an expedited review to take place.

The premises are situated on 2 Queen Street, Manchester City Centre and the premises licence was issued on 22/07/2014. The Premises Licence Holder (PLH) is OOTF LTD and the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) is Leonard Cunningham.

During the morning of Sunday 19th September 2021, customers from two separate tables in the VIP area started fighting, Door staff moved the customers into the main bar area where they continued to fight. Bar furniture was thrown by customers and metal barrier poles.

During the melee a customer was knocked unconscious, resulting in the male having to be taken to hospital. Innocent customers and staff can be seen running away in fear from the groups fighting.

Door staff split the two groups up taking one group out of the rear exit, the other group out of the main entrance, where the disorder continued.

Once outside metal barrier poles and rope were continued to be used as weapons by both the door staff and customers who were ejected. Two cars that were parked outside were had their windows smashed by 2 males who were ejected.

Door staff can be seen chasing the males towards Deansgate, whilst carrying barrier poles and ropes to be used as weapons, the whole incident lasted over 50 minutes

A Crime report for Section 18 Wounding and a crime for Violent Disorder have been submitted and enquiries are continuing to trace the offenders.

This investigation is in its early stages and there will no doubt be more information uncovered over the coming weeks but what is clear is that serious disorder and serious crimes have occurred at the premise.

The powers under sections 53A to 53C of the 2003 Act, are aimed at tackling serious crime and serious disorder.

The powers contained under section 53A of the Licensing Act 2003 are necessary and proportionate in light of the association that the premises has to serious crime and serious disorder.

In the interim Greater Manchester Police would request that the Licensing Authority consider suspension of the Premises Licence until the full review is heard before the committee. Serious Crime and serious disorder has occurred at the premises and until the Licensing Committee hear the full review and all the evidence that will be disclosed, to allow the premises to continue to operate as a licensed premises gives concerns that further crime will occur and place customers and staff in danger.. Greater Manchester Police will say that the licensing objectives of the prevention of crime and disorder can only be promoted if the premises licence was suspended until the final determination of the summary review application.

The standard review of the premises licence under section 51 Licensing Act 2003 is inappropriate due to length of time a standard review would take, there are serious concerns in relation to the violence and serious disorder at the premises.
