A Leeds bartender made it through to the finals of a global cocktail competition after wowing judges with her entry influenced from a year of living and studying in Shanghai.

[REDACTED] was awarded fourth place in the competition – competing against finalists from 42 other countries.

The global finals were held in Bourges France, where [REDACTED] presented her unique and visually stunning cocktail 'Tianshan Market' to the Monin Cup judges.
