Premises Licence Application. Royal Vida

Following on from a conversation with constable Isherwood of The GMP licensing team. I can confirm the following which may have a bearing on your representations to the Licensing committee hearing on 20th May 2024.

1. Mr Ali has instructed me to amend the operating hours following concerns received in the form of representations
Supply of alcohol
Monday- Tuesday 1100hrs to 22.00 hrs (previously 0200hrs)
Sunday Wednesday and Thursday 1100hrs to 0200hrs
Friday and Saturday 1100hrs to 0400hrs

Late night refreshment
Sunday Wednesday and Thursday 2300hrs to 0200hrs
Friday and Saturday 2300hrs to 0400hrs

Opening hours
Monday and Tuesday 1100hrs to 2230hrs (previously 0230hrs)
Wednesday Thursday and Sunday 1100hrs to 0230hrs
Friday and Saturday 1100hrs to 0430hrs.

In summary we have removed the late night opening on Monday and Tuesdays.
Closing will be restricted to 0230hrs on 3 days and 0430hrs on Friday and Saturday.

With regard to the use of Door supervisors the use of knife arch and body cameras. Up until 2200hrs each day the premises will be a restaurant encouraging all ages. Food will be the main reason for persons attending. We are happy for a condition **that reads after 2200hrs**

the use of door staff, the knife arch and body cam coverage will be utilised. We are also happy to include that from 2200hrs 2 door supervisors not 1 will wear body cameras.

With regard to the use of glassware. Once again the restaurant until 2200hrs will be a family restaurant however we are happy to include a condition that states **The glassware bottle security and table service will apply at all times whilst the premises are open.**

With regard to queue management this is relevant after 2200hrs when the restaurant closes. We are happy to have included a condition that reads **Under queue management door supervisors after 2200hrs door supervisors will monitor any queuing for entry to the premises and ensure as far as is possible that any noise emanating from queuing patrons is kept to a minimum.**


With regard to the IDSCAN system. This was an oversight on my part. We are happy for a condition that reads **after 2200hrs a IDSSCAN system will be utilised.**

With regard to the issue of door staff being positioned at the Junction of Longwith Street and Artillery Street, we are happy for a condition to be in place that reads **2 doorstaff will be positioned at the Junction of Longwith street and Artillery Street from 30 minutes before the premises closes until 30m minutes after it closes .**

I hope this clarifies our wish to work with the police and licensing authority to ensure the 4 licensing objectives are met and supports a robust operating schedule.
