CN/19/17 Compulsory Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

The Committee considered a report of the Chief Executive which sought approval for the initiation of the compulsory review of polling districts and polling places within the city. The Committee took into consideration the requirement by the Electoral Administration and Registration Act 2013, that compulsory reviews of parliamentary polling districts and polling places must take place every 5 years and the Authority's last compulsory review came into effect in February 2014. The Council was therefore required to undertake the next compulsory review within the 16 month period between 1 October 2018 and 31 January 2020.

- 2. To authorise the initiation of the compulsory review of polling districts and polling places within the Council's area beginning on 15 July 2019.

- 4. To delegate authority for undertaking the review to the Chief Executive.
- 5. To request that the Chief Executive reports back to the Committee upon completion of the review, so that the Committee can make final recommendations on polling districts and polling places to the City Council.
