### a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

At 24:00 each day all lighting will be turned off in the cabinets displaying alcohol, and Notices will be placed in these areas to confirm that alcohol is not currently available for purchase.

Any person who appears to be intoxicated or who is behaving in a disorderly manner shall not be allowed entry to the premises.

All staff shall be trained in recognising signs of drunkenness, how to refuse service and the Conditions attached to the Premises Licence. Training shall be regularly refreshed and training records shall be made available for inspection upon request to GMP or an authorised Officer of the Local Authority.

## b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points, will be covered. The CCTV cameras shall continually record while the premises are open to the public and recording shall be kept available and unedited for a minimum of 28 days with the date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the CCTV system shall be premises on the premises at all times when they are open to the public and must be able to produce/download/burn CCTV images upon request by a Police Officer or an authorised officer of the Local Authority.

An Incident Log, which may be electronically recorded, shall be kept at the premises for at least six months. This will be made available upon requests to GMP or an authorised Officer of the Local Authority.

### c) Public safety

All firefighting equipment will be inspected and serviced in line with the manufacturer's guidelines.

A direct telephone number for the Manager of the premises shall be available at the premises. This telephone number will be made available to residents in the vicinity.

#### d) The prevention of public nuisance

The premises and immediate surrounding area shall be kept clean and free from litter at all times the premises are open to the public.

All deliveries of alcohol from the premises shall be collected by an employee of Deliveroo or any similar home delivery service.

# e) The protection of children from harm

The premises shall display prominent signage indicating that it is an offence to buy or attempt to buy, alcohol for a person under the age of 18.

The Challenge 25 Scheme will be operated to ensure that any person who appears to be under the age of 25 shall provide documented proof that he/she is over 18 years of age. Proof of age shall only comprise a Passport, photo card driving licence or a card bearing the PASS hologram.

A log shall be kept at the premises to record all refused sales of alcohol for the reason that persons is/are or appear to be under 18 years of age. The log shall record the date and time of the refusal and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The log will be available upon request by GMP or an authorised officer of the Local Authority.

In addition to other training, the Premises Licence holder shall ensure that staff are trained to prevent underage sales, are aware of and prevent proxy sales and maintain the refusals log.
