The data presented here is intended to provide an overview of Highways activity in the ward, by detailing completed work orders, and summarising CRM activity and parking notices issued, as well as listing major schemes scheduled to take place in the ward.

This site draws on historical data from a rolling 12-month period and should not be confused with the Members Map Browser, which is linked directly to CRM and displays real-time data.

The data will be refreshed on a quarterly basis with the latest available performance data.

- From July 2018 to June 2019 a total of 399 work orders were completed in the ward to repair highways defects.
- From this total, 278 work orders were to repair potholes in the carriageway, 198 were repairs to footway defects and 7115 were other defect types
- In the same period 408 reports of highways defects were logged on CRM by members of the public, of which 259 were reports of patholas (63%)
- A total of 6875 penalty charge notices were issued for parking offences in the ward.
