Live music - Mon to Sunday 11am to 2am

Opening hours - Mon to Sunday 11am to 2:30am

Non Standard timings:-

From the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on New Year's Day.

An additional hour on the day British Summer Time begins to disapply its effect.

Representations received	
Greater Manchester Police	Due to the sale of alcohol hours of 4am being applied for and 4:30am closing. The grounds for objection are crime and disorder, public nuisance and public safety. Further steps would be needed to promote the Licensing Objectives. If the licence were to be granted the above amended hours and the below conditions should be added to the premises licence.

Agreements between parties

Greater Manchester Police:

The requirement for doorstaff shall be determined in accordance with a risk assessment carried out by the DPS. When employed doorstaff shall wear hi-vis armbands.

From 2100 hours each day the NiteNet radio system shall be operated at the premises.

When employed at least one member of door staff situated at the entrance to the premises shall wear and use a body cam to capture incidents of violence and/or antisocial behaviour and all ejections. The footage shall be able to be downloaded and stored for 28 days and made available to Police and council officers on request
