

## Schedule of Licence Conditions

Conditions consistent with the operating schedule	Agreed	Proposed by
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All staff shall be trained in recognising signs of drunkenness; how to refuse service; company policies and procedures; the Conditions in force under this Premises Licence. Documented records of training completed shall be kept for each member of staff. Training shall be regularly refreshed and records shall be made available for inspection upon request by an Authorised Officer of the Local Authority or Greater Manchester Police.</li> <li>2. The Premises Licence holder shall ensure that the provision of Door Supervisors at the premises is appropriate to ensure the safe control of the premises, and shall review this on a regular basis and upon request from Greater Manchester Police.</li> <li>3. A written record shall be kept on the premises by the Designated Premises Supervisor of every person employed on the premises as a Door Supervisor in a register kept for that purpose.</li> <li>4. That record shall contain the following details:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. The door supervisor's name, date of birth and home address</li> <li>ii. his/her Security Industry Authority Licence number</li> <li>iii. the time and date he/she starts and finishes duty</li> <li>iv. the time of any meal breaks taken whilst on duty</li> <li>v. each entry shall be signed by the Door Supervisor</li> </ol> </li> <li>5. That register shall be available for inspection on demand by an Authorised Officer of the Council, the Security Industry Authority or Greater Manchester Police.</li> <li>6. An Incident Log (which may be electronically recorded) shall be kept at the premises for at least six months, and made available upon request to an Authorised Officer of the Licensing Authority or Greater Manchester Police.</li> <li>7. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points will be covered. The CCTV cameras shall continually record while the premises are open to the public and recording shall be kept available and unedited for a minimum of 28 days.</li> <li>8. All firefighting equipment will be inspected and serviced in line with the appropriate British Standard.</li> <li>9. No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises that gives rise to a nuisance.</li> </ol>	N/A	Applicant

Staff shall monitor customers smoking outside of the premises on a regular basis and ensure patrons do not cause a public nuisance.</p> <p>11. All amplified music to go through an acoustic noise limiter installed at the premises and which will be set at a level agreed with the Environmental Health Officer at Manchester City Council.</p> <p>12. Notices shall be prominently displayed requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and leave the area quietly.</p> <p>13. The external seating area will be clearly defined with a physical structure to ensure customers do not stray beyond the permitted areas with alcohol.</p> <p>14. All outside areas to be clear of furniture by 23:00.</p> <p>15. Except for access and egress, or in case of emergency, all doors and windows to remain closed after 23:00.</p> <p>16. The Challenge 25 Scheme will be operated to ensure that any person who appears to be under the age of 25 shall provide documented proof that he/she is over 18 years of age. Proof of age shall comprise a passport, photo card driving licence or a card bearing the PASS hologram.</p> <p>17. Staff will be trained to prevent underage sales and drunkenness. Documented records of training shall be kept for each member of staff. Training shall be regularly refreshed and records shall be made available for inspection upon request by a Police Officer or an Authorised Officer of the Local Authority.</p>

The hours of licensable activities will be reduced to 00:15 Fri and Sat with the premises closing by 00:30.</li> <li>5.
