The licence holder shall ensure that any additional CCTV is installed, maintained and operated at the premises where this is considered to be appropriate.</li> <li>2. The licence holder shall undertake written risk assessments to ensure that events which require door supervisors are identified and an appropriate number of SIA registered door Supervisors shall be employed at these events.</li> <li>3. An incident log (which may be electronically recorded) shall be kept at the premises for at least six months and made available on request to the Police or an authorised officer of the licensing authority, which will record the following incidents including pertinent details.</li> <li>4. In addition to any other training, the premises licence holder shall ensure all staff are trained to prevent underage sales, to be aware of and prevent proxy sales, to maintain the refusals log and monitor staff to ensure their training is put into practice. Documented records of training completed shall be kept for each member of staff.</li> <li>5. Training shall be regularly refreshed and at no greater than 6 monthly intervals.</li> <li>6. Training records shall be made available for inspection upon request by a police officer or an authorised officer of Manchester City Council</li> <li>7. <p>8. Risk assessments to be completed for all events to identify whether Door Supervisors are required</p> <p>9. The Challenge 25 scheme must be operated to ensure that any person who appears to be under the age of 25 shall provide documented proof that he/she is over 18 years of age. Proof of age shall only comprise a passport, photo card driving licence, an HM Forces warrant card, or a card bearing the PASS hologram.</p> <p>10. Public liability insurance shall be maintained for the premises. Meet all Fire, Health and safety standards.</p> <p>11. The premises licence holder shall ensure that at all times when the public is present there is at least one competent person able to administer first aid, that an adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials is available on the premises, and that adequate records are maintained in relation to the supply of any first aid treatment.</p> <p>12. The premises and immediate surrounding area shall be kept clean and free from litter at all times the premises are open to the public.</p> <p>13. A log shall be kept at the premises and record all refused sales of alcohol for the reasons that the person(s) is, or appear to be under 18 years of age. The log shall record the date and time of the refusal and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale.</p> <p>14. The premises shall display prominent signage indicating at any point of sale, at the entrance to the premises and in all areas where alcohol is located that the Challenge 25 scheme is in operation.</p> <p>15. No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises that gives rise to a nuisance. Doors and windows shall be closed when considered necessary.</p> <p>16. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18 in the bar area after 18.00</p>
