Representation

Outline your representation regarding the above application below. This representation should describe the likely effect of the grant of the licence/certificate on the licensing objectives and on the vicinity of the premises.

The Licensing and Out of Hours Team (LOOHT) have assessed the likely impact of the grant of this application taking into account a number of factors, including the nature of the area in which the premises is located and any potential risk the granting of this licence could lead to issues of public nuisance.

In reaching this decision the LOOHT have also given particular consideration to Manchester City Council's Statement of Licensing Policy 2016 -2021, specifically:

8 Manchester Standards (MS2) – Manchester City Council has identified standards that we expect of licensed premises in terms of promoting the licensing objectives through effective general management of the premises. Effective management of the premises is integral to ensuring the operator's policies and procedures, as well as licence conditions, are actively enforced at the premises.

Where its discretion is engaged, the licensing authority will ensure that due consideration is given to the proximity of licensed premises not only to local residents and businesses, but also in relation to other licensed premises, to ensure they are located in a position that does not adversely affect their ability to ensure the promotion of the licensing objectives. The potential impact on any local residents will be an important matter for consideration.

The authority will give particular consideration to measures proposed in the application in relation to prevent public nuisance.

The licensing authority will give consideration to the appropriateness of hours applied for, having regard to the location of premises and their likely effect on the promotion of the four licensing objectives.

The authority considers that later hours will typically be more sensitive and

higher risk in causing problems.

The location of the premises is on Mauldeth Road which is just outside of the main stress area for Withington, however is local to residents and other establishments which could give way to noise nuisance. Since the licence was granted there has been no complaints of noise nuisance from residents.

This premises have a planning restriction advising they are only allocated to open until 11pm Monday – Saturday and 10pm on a Sunday. The grant of this licence would need to be granted by planning prior to the hours being used at the premises.

The premises currently serves hot food until 2am, they have requested to extend this service and serve hot food until 4am. After speaking with the applicant they have agreed last service of food will be 0345am and close the premises at 0400am.

All conditions previously agreed are to remain on the licence.

I am emailing to object to the above application. I objected to the original application, which requested opening hours until 5am. This was eventually revised down to 2am.
