

Sales of alcohol for consumption Off the premises shall only be supplied with a takeaway meal.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points, will be covered. The CCTV cameras shall continually record while the premises are open to the public and recording shall be kept available and unedited for a minimum of 28 days with the date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the CCTV system shall be available for contact at all times when they are open to the public and must be able to produce/download/burn CCTV images upon request by a Police Officer or an authorised officer of the Local Authority.

An Incident Log, which may be electronically recorded, shall be kept at the premises for at least six months. This will be made available upon requests to GMP or an authorised Officer of the Local Authority.

All staff shall be trained in recognising signs of drunkenness, how to refuse service and the Conditions attached to the Premises Licence. Training shall be regularly refreshed and training records shall be made available for inspection upon request to GMP or an authorised Officer of the Local Authority.

Any person who appears to be intoxicated or who is behaving in a disorderly manner shall not be allowed entry to the premises.

All deliveries of alcohol from the premises shall be carried out by employees of the premises. Please see the attached Delivery Policy.

c) Public safety

d) The prevention of public nuisance

A direct telephone number for the Manager of the premises shall be available at the premises. This telephone number will be made available to residents in the vicinity.

Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the area quietly.

Management and staff shall ensure that any litter generated by customers in the immediate vicinity is collected both during and after the close of operational hours.

A prominent, clear and legible notice shall be displayed at the exit of the premises to remind customers to dispose of their litter responsibly.

e) The protection of children from harm

A log shall be kept at the premises to record all refused sales of alcohol for the reason that persons is/are or appear to be under 18 years of age. The log shall record the date and time of the refusal and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The log will be available upon request by GMP or an Authorised Officer of the Local Authority.

 - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
