The road to ruin which has 22 licensed premises in ONE mile



A busy road on the outskirts of Manchester city centre has been dubbed 'Alcohol Alley' - because it has a staggering 22 licensed premises which sell alcohol.

Among the many places to buy drink, Moston Lane in Moston, north Manchester has six off-licences - five of which are within 400 yards of each other.
