### Agreements between parties

#### **Greater Manchester Police:**

 SIA registered door staff will be employed at a ratio of 1:100 with a minimum of 2 on duty from 2300 hours until 30 minutes after closing, to assist with the orderly dispersal of customers. Door staff will wear hi-vis armbands whilst on duty.

### **Licensing & Out of Hours Compliance:**

- Alcohol consumed outside the premises shall only be consumed by patrons seated at tables.
- All windows and external doors shall be kept closed between 23:00 hours and 08:00 hours, or at any time when regulated entertainment takes place, except for the immediate access and egress of persons.
- Patrons permitted to temporarily leave and then re-enter the premises, e.g. to smoke after 23:00 hours, shall not be permitted to take drinks or glass containers with them.
- Staff shall monitor customers smoking outside the premises on a regular basis and ensure patrons do not cause a public nuisance.
- There shall be a documented dispersal policy as agreed with the relevant responsible authorities implemented at the premises and a copy lodged with the Council's Licensing Unit.
