An incident log (which may be electronically recorded) shall be kept at the premises for at least six months, and made available on request to the Police or an authorised officer of the licensing authority, which shall record the following incidents including pertinent details: (a) all crimes reported to the venue, or by the venue to the Police (b) all ejections of patrons (c) any incidents of disorder (d) any faults in the CCTV system (e) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service		
3.	The Designated Premises Supervisor shall ensure that a written notice of authority is kept at the premises for all staff who sell alcohol. The notice shall be made available for inspection upon request of the police or an authorised officer of the licensing authority and all staff selling alcohol must be in possession of formal identification to enable to verify their identity against the notice.		
4.	The premises shall have smoke detectors and fire extinguishers
