<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. CCTV shall be installed and maintained to the satisfaction of the Premises licence Holder and Licensing Officers. CCTV images will be retained for a minimum of 14 days and produced upon request of the police. Any malfunction of the CCTV will be recorded in the incident book.</li> <li>2. First aid equipment shall be available on the premises.</li> <li>3. All rubbish shall be removed from the public area on a regular basis.</li> <li>4. Telephone numbers of local taxi operators shall be displayed.</li> <li>5. To minimise the effect of littering, bins shall be provided inside the premises.</li> <li>6. At the end of each working day, litter shall be collected and stored inside the premises pending collection.</li> <li>7. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points and the street environment will be covered, enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public and recording shall be kept available and unedited for a minimum of 28 days with the date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public and must be able to produce / download / burn CCTV images upon request by a police officer or an authorised officer of the licensing authority. Any footage must be in a format so it can be played back on a standard personal computer or standard DVD player. Where the recording is on a removable medium (i.e. compact disc, flash card etc.), a secure storage system to store those recording mediums shall be provided.</li> <li>2. An incident log (which may be electronically recorded) shall be kept at the premises for at least six months, and made available on request to the Police or an authorised officer of the licensing authority, which will record the following incidents including pertinent details:</li> </ol>	Yes (all)	GMP
