<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. No bottles, glasses or similar items may be disposed of in outside receptacles between midnight and 06.00 hours. 2. All collections shall take place in a manner that will not cause a noise disturbance to the occupiers of any residential properties surround the premises. This includes the avoidance of slamming doors, playing loud music, shouting, overrevving engines and sounding horns to signal their arrival. The driver shall turn the engine off immediately upon arrival at the delivery address and will park considerately without causing any obstruction to the highway. 3. All deliveries of alcohol shall only be delivered to a premises address with a valid postcode and will only be delivered directly to that property. 4. Customers must be instructed when placing the order that they will not be able to collect the order from the vehicle. All deliveries will only be made directly to the property address and customers will not be permitted to take orders from the vehicle. 5. The premises licence holder shall provide the following information in writing to the licensing authority before any sale of alcohol is carried out: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The trading name of the company that will operate under the licence • All telephone numbers that will be used to accept orders • The URL/website address that will be used to accept orders. <p>Any change to this information must be notified to the licensing authority within 7 days.</p> 6. All deliveries of alcohol from the premises shall be collected by an employee of Deliveroo. Any change to another similar home-delivery courier service can only be made once evidence has been provided which satisfies the Responsible Authority, that the licensing objectives will be upheld and agreement is made.
