<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All staff engaged in the sale of alcohol shall be trained with regards to the Challenge 25 policy and sales of alcohol by proxy. This training shall be documented, and training shall be refreshed at no greater than 6 monthly Intervals.</li> <li>2. The Premises Licence Holder shall ensure that signage demonstrating the Challenge 25 policy as well as selling alcohol to children by proxy are placed at the entrance to the premises as well as being displayed in all areas serving alcohol.</li> <li>3. CCTV covering the external areas of the premises and regular staff patrols to ensure persons under 18 years of age are not encouraging adults to purchase alcohol on their behalf.</li> <li>4. A log shall be kept and record all instances when alcohol has been refused for the reasons that the person(s) is, or appear to be, under 18 years of age. The log shall record the date and time of the refusal and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The log will be available on request by the police or an authorised officer of Manchester City Council. The log shall be checked on a regular basis by the Designated Premises Supervisor to ensure that it is being used by staff and each check shall be recorded in the log.</li> </ol>	No	The Trading Standards Service

Supply of alcohol ON the premises should cease at 11.30 pm (Supply of alcohol OFF the premises should be refused altogether)</li> <li>7.
