Greater Manchester Police

The applicant has stated with the application that their intention is to provide customers with one complementary alcoholic drink whilst they wait for their haircut. As such GMP would ask that this becomes a condition on the premises licence to ensure that this remains the case and that the Licensing Objectives are upheld.

### Agreements between parties

**Greater Manchester Police:**

1. Alcohol may only be provided to persons waiting for a haircut or styling. Only one alcoholic drink may be provided to any person waiting for a haircut or styling.
