

## Schedule of Licence Conditions

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and leave the area quietly.</li> <li>2. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system. All public areas of the licensed premises, including all public entry and exit points, and the street environment will be covered, enabling facial identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV cameras shall continually record while the premises are open to the public and recording shall be kept available and unedited for a minimum of 28 days with the date and time stamping. A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be present on the premises at all times when they are open to the public and must be able to produce/download/burn CCTV images upon request by a police officer or an authorised officer of the licensing authority. Any footage must be in a format that can be played back on a standard personal computer or standard DVD player. Where the recording is on a removable medium (i.e. compact disc, flash card etc), a secure storage system to store those recording mediums shall be provided.</li> <li>3. A log shall be kept at the premises to record all refused sales of alcohol for the reasons that the person(s) is/are, or appear(s) to be, under 18 years of age. The log shall record the date and time of the refusal and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The log will be available on request by the police or an authorised officer of Manchester City Council. The log shall be checked on a regular basis by the Designated Premises Supervisor to ensure that it is being used by staff and each check shall be recorded in the log.</li> </ol>	N/A	Applicant

The Challenge 25 scheme must be operated to ensure that any person who appears to be under the age of 25 shall provide documented proof that he/she is over 18 years of age. Proof of age shall only comprise a passport, photo card driving licence, an HM Forces warrant card, or a card bearing the PASS hologram.</li> <li>2. All staff engaged in the sale of alcohol will be trained with regards to the Challenge 25 policy. This training will be documented, and training should be refreshed annually.</li> <li>3. 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<p>demonstrating the Challenge 25 policy as well as selling alcohol to children by proxy are placed at the entrance to the premises as well as being displayed in all areas serving alcohol. Staff training should incorporate this.</p> <p>4. The Premise Licence Holder will also ensure regular checks are made around or outside of the premises for underage persons encouraging adults to buy alcohol for them.</p>
