GMP object to the grant of this Temporary Event Notice on the grounds of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder, the Prevention of Public Nuisance and Public Safety.

This application seeks to allow the use of a car park for the sale of alcohol, regulated entertainment and late night refreshment from 2pm until 11.30pm for up to 499 people.

As such GMP would have expected a comprehensive event management plan and an alcohol management plan to have been submitted along with this TEN. Also a detailed security plan which shows the numbers of SIA door staff and their positions within the event site.

With these important documents not being included it leaves GMP in a position where we are concerned that the Licensing Objectives will be undermined, as it is not
