Please accept this letter as formal notification that Greater Manchester Police wish to object, under Section 104(2) of the Licensing Act 2003, to the **TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE** detailed below, as we are satisfied that granting the application under these circumstances would undermine the Licensing Objectives.

TIME OF EVENT:	1100 – 0400 hrs

The basis of our objection is to Prevent Public Nuisance.

This application is seeking to allow an outdoor event from 11am until 4am the next morning for 3 consecutive days. The applicant has applied to be allowed to sell alcohol, provide late night refreshment and provide regulated entertainment. They are expecting up to 150 persons at any one time.

GMP are firmly of the opinion that to run an outdoor event with regulated entertainment until 4am is almost certainly going to cause a level of noise nuisance which is unacceptable to persons who live in the proximity of the premises. There are a large number of residential properties along St Mary's Parsonage and the noise from the DJ is likely to funnel down this street causing a disturbance to those residents.

We therefore ask that this TEN application is refused.
