Summary

On 8 June 2021, Manchester along with the rest of Greater Manchester and parts of Lancashire were designated as an ‘enhanced response area’ (era). This designation officially ended on 26 July, however, Manchester has continued to implement the local era action plan throughout August. It is likely that Manchester and other areas with enduring higher transmission rates will be invited to be part of a longer term national programme up to April 2022. In anticipation of this the Manchester COVID-19 12 Point Plan has been refreshed and is attached.

At the meeting of the Board, the Director of Public Health (DPH) will provide an update on the Plan including the latest data and intelligence and the Medical Director, Manchester Health and Care Commissioning will also provide the update on the Citywide Vaccination Programme including the Winter Phase 3 Plans.
