The supply of alcohol for consumption both on and off the premises:

Mon to Sun 10am to 10pm

Seasonal variation: From the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on New Year's Day.

Opening hours:

Mon to Sun 8am to 10.30pm

Seasonal variation : From the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on New Year's Day.

Representations received

Residents Association

The resident's association objected to the application due to concerns relating to potential disturbance from the premises. The association were concerned that the use of the rear yard would lead to increases in noise pollution

Agreements between parties

1. Access and egress to the rear yard will be through the shop entrance on Burton Road.
2. Patrons will be seated in the rear yard when consuming an alcoholic beverage
3. The capacity of the rear yard will be 16 people
4. Customers will use the toilet situated inside the premises
