| What is the decision? | The approval of Capital Expenditure of £24,601,000 to proceed with National Cycling Centre refurbishment project into construction phase |

The works will use sustainable materials, increasing the lifespan of the build by 20 years and will contribute to carbon reduction targets, with anticipated carbon savings of 517 tonnes of per annum and 62% reduction of on-site energy. |
