Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

Door Supervisors

Only individuals licensed by the Security Industry Authority shall be used at the premises to undertake security activities, which include guarding against: -

- a) Unauthorised access or occupation (e.g. through door supervision),
- b) Outbreaks of disorder, or
- c) Damage

Exhibition of films

The admission of children under the age of 18 to film exhibitions permitted under the terms of this certificate shall be restricted in accordance with any recommendations made:

- a) by the British Board of Film Classification (BBFC) where the film has been classified by that Board, or
- b) by the Licensing Authority where no classification certificate has been granted by the BBFC, or where the licensing authority has notified the club which holds the certificate that section 20 (3) (b) (74 (3)(b) for clubs) of the Licensing Act 2003 applies to the film.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

1. An effective and adequate CCTV system equipped with a recording facility shall be installed, maintained and operated at the premises. Recorded images shall be retained for 31 days.
2. All exit doors shall be easily openable and such doors shall be regularly checked to ensure that they are not obstructed and that they function satisfactorily.
3. Public liability insurance shall be maintained for the premises.
4. A safety plan shall be implemented that shall include fire safety and maintenance inspections.
5. Fire fighting equipment shall be maintained and serviced according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

1. There shall be on going risk assessment by management of the need for door staff. Door staff shall be appointed whenever and in such number as deemed appropriate by the risk assessment.
2. A notice shall be displayed at the entrance to the premises requesting customers to leave quietly.
3. Entry to the premises shall be limited to members only.
4. There shall be no entry for persons under eighteen years of age.
