Agreements between parties

Greater Manchester Police:

- There shall be a minimum of 2 SIA registered door supervisors on duty from 21:00 hours until 30 minutes after closing time at all times the venue is open.
- There shall also be a minimum ratio of 1 SIA registered door supervisor to every 100 customers from 21:00 hours until 30 minutes after closing time at all times the venue is open.
- All door supervisors employed at the venue shall wear high visibility jackets at all times.

Licensing & Out of Hours Compliance:

- There shall be a documented dispersal policy drawn up by the Premises
 Licence Holder or the Designated Premises Supervisor and implemented at the
 premises. This policy shall be agreed with the relevant responsible authorities
 prior to the premises opening for the first time and a copy lodged with the
 Councils Licensing Unit.
- There shall be a documented smoking policy drawn up by the Premises
 Licence Holder or the Designated Premises Supervisor and implemented at the
 premises. This policy shall be agreed with the relevant responsible authorities
 prior to the premises opening for the first time and a copy lodged with the
 Councils Licensing Unit.
- Patrons permitted to temporarily leave and then re-enter the premises, e.g. to smoke, shall not be permitted to take drinks or glass containers with them.
