## Your Representation

Please accept this representation as extra information towards Greater Manchester Police's support for the above Premises Licence Review.

Following our previous representation which was submitted earlier this year GMP wish to submit the following further evidence.

On Wednesday $1^{\text {st }}$ December 2021 I attended at Euro Market, 402 Cheetham Hill Road, Manchester in company with Mr Devon Bennett from Manchester City Council Trading Standards to conduct a licensing inspection.

A lengthy discussion took place between Mr. Bennett and the male who was in charge, Barham Bakir Mohammed, which was to do with cigarettes and non -compliant packaging. Once Mr. Bennett had finished his conversation with Mr. Mohammed I and went through the conditions of the premises licence with him and it was found that the premises were in breach of the following conditions:

- There was no written notice of authority to sell alcohol being at the premises, a breach of Condition 3, Annex 3 There were no records of any staff training on the premises which is breach of Condition 6, Annex 3

This premises licence has recently been transferred into the name of the current Premises Licence Holder, Euro Market at 402 Ltd, but it is clear that the previous issues with illicit cigarettes and breach of licence conditions remain and therefore GMP are in even more convinced that the Premises Licence should be revoked.

The premises continue to undermine the licensing objectives and show no signs of attempting to uphold them.
