Please outline your representation below and continue overleaf.

Please accept this as formal notification of the Greater Manchester Police support of the Review of the Premises Licence of Tribeca. GMP is firmly of the opinion that these premises are undermining the Licensing Objectives of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder, the Prevention of Public Nuisance and Public Safety.

The Premises Licence Holder (PLH) is currently BPC Leisure limited and the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) is Hazel O'Keefe, who has held this position since April 2020 but she has been involved with the management of the premises since June 2018.

Over the previous couple of years GMP and the Manchester City Council Licensing and Out if Hours Team (LOOH) have had reason to speak to the premises operators fairly regularly in relation to issues arising at the premises and breaches of their Premises Licence. However, despite these meetings, warnings and action plans the premises still continue to cause issues and breach their licence and therefore GMP agree with the decision of LOOH to bring the Premises licence for review, as there are no other options left for us to explore.

The following is a summary of incents reported to GMP and meetings, conversations and visits that GMP have had with the premises operators over the previous few years.

On 15 th March 2019 a meeting took place between PC Braithwaite and a representative of a security company. At this meeting informed PC Braithwaite that she wasn't currently the DPS but that she would be had completed her Personal Licence course and would then be in day-to-day control of the premises. An incident which had occurred at the premises on 3 rd March 2019 was discussed. This incident related to a fight within the premises in which a knife was taken from behind the bar by an offender who has then threatened othe customers with the knife. The points raised by PC Braithwaite in relation to this incident was the lack of research into the promoter of the event during which the incident occurred, only having 2 door staff on duty instead of 3 and knives being left within the reach of customers. This incident occurred on only second night as venue operator. A contact sheet was completed in relation to this meeting and I now submit this as exhibit AEI/1 and this can be found at page 5 of the bundle.
On 29th June 2019 PC Braithwaite carried out a licensing visit at the promises between 2015 hours and 2020

On 9th February 2020 PC Braithwaite carried out a licensing visit at the premises between 0140 hours and 0225 hours. There was found to be only one SIA door staff on duty when their licence condition stipulates that they should have a minimum of 2 on Friday and Saturday. Also, the staff weren't able to show footage on the CCTV system to the officers. was asked if she had a letter of authority from American Stated that they did. She went off and then came back a couple of minutes later and produced one which looked very much



like it had just been written as the ink still appeared to be wet. When questioned on this she admitted that she had indeed just written it. PC Braithwaite took a picture of the letter that had just written and scanned it onto the visit sheet. I now submit this visit sheet as exhibit AEI/3 and this can be found at pages 9-10 of the bundle.

At 0401 hours on 16th February 2020 GMP received a 999 call stating that there were 7-8 people trying to get inside the premises and that they had been fighting and the owner had been hit in the face. Police attended at the premises and helped to break up the fighting and a male was arrested for Common Assault. During this arrest a police officer was hit by another male and this male was also arrested for assaulting an Emergency worker. During the ejection of the males a member of door staff was also punched in the face. 2 crimes for Common Assault and a crime for Assault of an Emergency worker were later submitted. The incident report and the 3 crimes are now submitted as exhibits AEI/4, AEI/5, AEI/6 and AEI/7 and these can be found at pages 11-17 of the bundle.

On 19th February 2020 PC Braithwaite carried out a licensing visit at the premises between 1800 hours and 1840 hours in company with LOOH. The DPS and and rere present at the time. During the visit stated that she was to become the DPS as she was now in day-to-day control of the premises. A copy of the letter of authority that had hastily written on 9th February was shown to and he confirmed that the signature on the letter was not his. Stated that she couldn't find the letter of authority on the night so she had written the one she produced on the night an forged and stated that all the staff would be fully trained in its use and have access to it. I now submit this visit sheet as exhibit AEI/8 and this can be found at page 19 of the bundle.

At 0148 Hours on 1st March 2020 GMP were contacted by a member of the public via email who stated that she had been in the premises a couple of hours earlier and whilst he was there a female had slapped him across the face and thrown a drink over him and that another person had also pushed him. A crime for Common Assault was later submitted and I now submit this crime report as exhibit AEI/9 and this can be found at page 21 of the bundle.

On 7th March 2020 PC Braithwaite carried out a licensing visit at the premises with LOOH between 0015 hours and 0030 hours and on this visit the premises was found to be compliant with the conditions on the premises licence. I now submit a copy of this visit sheet as exhibit AEI/10 and this can be found at page 23 of the bundle.

At 0404 hours the same morning GMP received a 999 call stating that further patrols were required at the premises as there was a group of people causing issues. Patrols attended and found that the premises was closing and that a group was reluctant to leave and were being abusive. Patrols remained outside the premises for about 30 minute to ensure that no further trouble ensued. I now submit this incident report as exhibit AEI/11 and this can be found at page 25 of the bundle.

National Lockdown for Coronavirus starts at the end of March 2020.

At 0114 hours on 16th August 2020 GMP received 2 999 calls, one stating that 20 people were fighting at the premises and the other stating that there was a fight ongoing at the premises. There was a further update at 0115 hours stating that there was 1 security guard trying to stop it. At 0118 hours a police officer updated that there was a male at the location with the end of his nose missing and at that time it was assumed it had been bitten off, however further enquiries found that the male had been in a fight with another male and during this fight the victim has been dragged face down along the road resulting in the injury to his nose. A crime for a Section 18 Wounding was later submitted. I now submit the 2 incident reports and the crime report as exhibits AEI/12, AEI/13 and AEI/14 and these can be found at pages 27-31 of the bundle.

On 21st August 2020 PC Braithwaite carried out a visit at the premises in company with LOOH to discuss the incident on 16th August where the male was assaulted and suffered the serious injury to his nose. It was discovered that the incident book at the premises had not been completed despite all the door staff on duty being involved in dealing with the incident. Informed the officers that a rough copy had been done but wasn't available to view, with the intention of completing the incident book later. PC Braithwaite informed that the incident book should be completed as soon as possible after an incident, especially one where such a serious injury has occurred. There was also an issue with the CCTV being viewed during the visit due to forgetting the password. I now submit this contact sheet as exhibit AEI/15 and this can be found at page 33 of the bundle.

At 0040 hours on 23rd August 2020 GMP received a 999 call stating that further police patrols were required at the premises. Police officers attended and found that there was a group who had been having a verbal dispute at the premises but it had all calmed down and no offences were disclosed. I now submit this incident report as

On 18th September 2020 PC Braithwaite carried out a visit at the premises in company with LOOH and during this visit the DPS was not present. All the conditions of the licence were found to be being adhered to. I now submit this visit sheet as exhibit AEI/17 and this can be found at page 37 of the bundle. On 24th September 2020 PC Braithwaite carried out a visit to the premises in company with LOOH and during this visit the new Covid Regulations were fully explained to and the CCTV coverage was checked. I now submit this visit sheet as exhibit AEI/18 and this can be found at pages 39-40 of the bundle. At 2314 hours on 17th October 2020 GMP received a 999 call from a council licensing officer stating that there were at least 30 people inside the premises. Police officers attended with LOOH and and told the officers that there were only a couple of others present but on entering the premises another 7 people were found to be present and were drinking. Under the Tier 2 regulations at the time it was illegal to have more than 6 people together inside the venue from multiple households after 10pm so a Fixed Penalty Notice admitted breaching the regulations. It later was discovered that the penalty notice was not paid so the matter was referred to the Magistrates Court and the operators were later found guilty of operating the premises in contravention of the Tier 2 regulations and were fined £1760. I now submit a copy of this incident report as exhibit AEI/19 and this can be found at page 41 of the bundle. On 17th June 2021 a meeting was held between Harman PC Braithwaite and LOOH and the discussions was around the running of the premises I general. It was highlighted that the incident book was poorly completed and missing several incidents of note. was advised that she needed to ensure that both staff and door staff were filling it out correctly. CCTV could not be accessed due to a password issue but the premises wasn't open at the time so this wasn't a breach of the licence. I now submit a copy of this contact sheet as exhibit AEI/20 and this can be found at page 43 of the bundle. On 25th June 2021 PC Braithwaite carried out a licensing visit at the premises between 2350 hours and 2355 hours in company with LOOH. It was discovered that the music was extremely loud and that customers were stood up drinking and some were dancing, which was in breach of the Coronavirus regulations at the time. The CCTV was checked and was found to only be recording for 7 days instead of 28 days as per the condition on the premises licence. I now submit a copy of this visit sheet as exhibit AEI/21 and this can be found at page 45 of the bundle. At 0411 hours on 25th July 2021 GMP received a 999 call stating that there was a disturbance at the premises. Police officers attended at the premises and it was established that there had been a fight there and that a member of staff had been hit over the head with a bottle resulting in a small cut. Whilst the officers were dealing with the incident one of the males involved in the original disturbance has returned to the premises and the fighting has started again requiring the officers to request further patrols to the location. The fighting was eventually brought under control but the offender who hit the staff member over the head with the bottle could not be identified. A crime for ABH and a crime for Affray were later submitted. I now submit the incident report and the crime reports as exhibits AEI/22, AEI/23 and AEI/24 and these can be found at pages 47-51 of the bundle. At 0139 hours on 7th August 2021 GMP received a 999 call stating that there was fighting at the premises. Police officers attended and it established that a male had been ejected from the premises by the door staff for causing issues inside and had then started to fight with the door staff and had punched one of them. The male was identified to the officers and was arrested for Common assault. A report of crime for common assault was later submitted and I now submit the incident report and crime report as exhibits AEI/25 and AEI/26 and these can be found at pages 53-55 of the bundle. At 0445 hours the same morning GMP were contacted by a male who stated that he had been in the premises at approximately 0230 hours and a male who he knows has assaulted him by hitting him in the head, face and body resulting in cuts to his face and a headache. A report of crime for ABH was later submitted and I now submit the incident report and crime report as exhibits AEI/27 and AEI/28 and these can be found at pages 57-59 of the bundle. On 21st August 2021PC Hammersley carried out a licensing visit at the premises between 2330 hours and 0010 hours as requested by PC Braithwaite. As a result of this visit PC Hammersley emailed PC Braithwaite and identified the following issues to him. The CCTV footage from the 27th July was requested by PC Hammersley but he was told that they didn't have it because the camera above the main entrance wasn't working on the night and the footage that they had saved on the hard drive only went back to the 28th July so wasn't compliant with

that an engineer would be called out on the Sunday to fix the issue with the CCTV retention.

Another issue which was identified is that one of the 3 door staff who was on duty on the night did not have an

SIA door badge with him and said he had left it in the car and went to retrieve it. This person was not signed in the door book so there were no details available for him. After waiting 15 minutes for this person to return there was still no sign of him. The other 2 door staff were from MSS Security and had their badges and were correctly signed in but the 3rd one, who went AWOL was not employed by MSS and had been arranged by directly. I now submit the visit sheet and a copy of the email as exhibits AEI/29 and AEI/30 and these can be found at pages 61-64 of the bundle. On 6th October 2021 a meeting was held at the premises with GMP and LOOH and was present the meeting. Several recent incidents were discussed. One was the arrest of an off duty member of staff from the premises who was arrested inside the premises on 25th September 2021 and then racially abused and assaulted the arresting officer. It was highlighted that following the incident that staff members were unwilling to provide statements but this was disputed by An event on 2nd October was discussed which was a ticket only event and had been oversold resulting in about 150 people with valid tickets being unable to gain entry as the premises was at capacity. The premises had taken the decision to close the premises early and a gradual dispersal of the customers was then facilitated but prior to this tensions had been running high and police had to attend to assist in the dispersal. PC Braithwaite that in future all externally promoted events are risk assessed. The assault which occurred on 7th August was also briefly discussed. Finally the incident book and its poor completion was discussed and PC Braithwaite stressed to moving forward there should be one incident book that it accessible to all staff and that entries should be made as soon after an incident as possible. It was also pointed out that the door staff signing in book was poorly completed and, in some places, illegible and it was stressed how important it is to maintain these books properly to comply with the conditions of the licence. I now submit this contact sheet as exhibit AEI/31 and this can be found at pages 65-66 of the bundle. At 0252 hours on 1st January 2022 GMP received a 999 call stating that here was fighting outside the premises. Police officers attended and by the time they had arrived the matter had been dealt with by the security staff and the offenders had been removed from the premises and been sent on their way. I now submit this incident report as exhibit AEI/32 and this can be found at page 67 of the bundle. At 0024 hours on 2nd January 2022 GMP received a 999 call stating that the premises was at capacity and that there was a large group of people still outside trying to gain entry. Police officers attended at the premises and at first everything seemed fine but it was clear that the event at the premises had been oversold. The premises called last orders early at 0120 hours and the officers monitored the situation but very quickly the mood changed and a request went out over the radio for all free patrols to make to the location the GMP Tactical Aid Unit was requested to attend. The officers at the location then had to adopt Public Order methods to deal with the surging angry crowd and they formed cordons across the street. The large crowd continued to cause issues and fighting broke out amongst some of them and officers had to draw their batons in order to bring the situation under control and disperse the large crowd. Eventually at 0230 hours the crowd had thinned out and moved away and the street returned to normality but this was over 2 hours from the initial call so it shows how large this disturbance was and how the overselling of the event contributed to A report of crime for Common assault and one for attempted Common assault were later submitted and I now submit the incident report and Crime reports as exhibits AEI/33, AEI/34 and AEI/35 and these can be found at pages 69-73 of the bundle. PC Braithwaite and other GMP officers have worked hard to try and assist the premises in sorting out their shortcomings and the number of meetings and visits reflects this, but unfortunately, we still find ourselves having to deal with unsavoury incidents at the premises and failings in the way the premises are managed.



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

Simon,

I visited Tribeca this evening as requested. Was present to ask about the CCTV from the incident 25/07/21. However, they don't have the footage of the incident for two reasons. Firstly, the camera (cam4) above the main entrance was not working on this date. I think this was the case, as when I have reviewed their CCTV it was also not working on other nearby dates. Secondly, the CCTV is only retained back to the 28/07/21 three days after this incident. This is an issue for the footage you requested, but also it does not comply with their licence condition requiring them to have footage retained for 28 days. I was tempted to issue a s.19 closure which I had in my pocket, but in the circumstances seemed a little harsh as they did have the most recent 25 days footage available. There was alatin dance night taking place with a dancefloor full of couples slow dancing. It wasn't particularly high risk. Assured me they would get an engineer out Sunday to fix the issue with the CCTV. I'm not in Sunday to check I'm have a booking between 7-8pm Sunday night. If not, I'm sure you will chase them up on Monday if Margaret isn't

Unfortunately this wasn't the only issue. There were two SIA door staff from MSS who were all badged up and signed in appropriately. They said they had been on the venue since Saturday and so far it had been going fine. There was a third doorman inside who was not from MSS but had been arranged by directly. I understand that this was to allow them to increase the number attending to around 300, although there were only around 65 present when I was there and I doubt it got much busier. When I asked this doorman for his badge (which appeared to be in his armband) he said he had left it in his car and immediately left the venue to get it. He wasn't signed in, so I don't have any details for him. After around 15 minutes waiting for him to return I gave up and left the premises. Ididn't have any more information about this 'doorman'. It didn't impact on the event continuing as they were still adhering to their SIA premises licence condition. It is however unsurprisingly poor from Tribeca again..

We also discussed door staff at Tribeca. Having parted ways with Serenity Security, you then employed MSS for a short period until a new company (S & G Security Services) started in early September this year. You said you have been pleased with the service provided but it



became clear from checking your Incident Book and Door Staff Signing In book that there are improvements to be made. The Incident Book was poorly completed, with months going by with no entries and entries not in date order. Moving forward, there should be one Incident Book at Tribeca, which is available to all staff (not just door staff). It should be clearly labelled and should not be taken off the premises. An entry should be made as soon as possible after an incident occurs, and definitely before they finish their shift. Every time a person is ejected, physical force is used by staff, there is a particularly problematic customer, the emergency services are called and anything else of note, an entry should be made, it should be dated, and signed with the person's name printed with an appropriate amount of detail. The signing in sheets were poorly completed and in some places illegible. If you don't have a signing in book that is made for that specific purpose, the signing in sheets you use should be placed in a ring binder for safety, SIA staff should sign in and sign out, write their full names and their full SIA numbers. To be sure you're doing everything you need to, please check your Premises Licence conditions relating to CCTV, door staff and Incident Books.

Moving forward, please consider all the above issues and try and devise ways in which you'll minimise the risk of similar incidents at Tribeca. We're committed to carry on working with you to ensure Tribeca runs as problem free as possible but as discussed in the meeting, the next step will be to take enforcement action, probably via a Licensing Review if we continually encounter crimes/incidents, and issues around how Tribeca is managed.







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
