Please accept this letter as formal notification that Greater Manchester Police wish to object, under Section 104(2) of the Licensing Act 2003, to the **TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE** detailed below, as we are satisfied that granting the application under these circumstances would undermine the Prevention of Crime and Disorder and the Prevention of Public Nuisance Objectives.

The application seeks to allow the applicant to use the building and adjacent land to hold an event for 100 persons with alcohol being sold throughout and music being played outside through a speaker.

The premises are in a densely residential area and the outdoor area which is attached to the premises is overlooked by numerous residential properties which are only a few metres away. Therefore it is highly likely that these residents will have to listen to the music being played over the speaker along with the voices of 100 customers for 8 ½ hours and GMP believes that this is unfair to those residents.

Holding the event on this land is almost certainly going to cause issues to the nearby residents which are wholly unacceptable.

Therefore Greater Manchester Police ask that this application is refused.
