Alternatives considered and rejected	Consideration was taken to appoint via the Bolton's framework for highways work: TC005, however it was decided that due to the multiple works that opening to the wider market would enable more competition, with additional bids, and a chance for additional value for money for Manchester City Council. As part of the highway maintenance pipeline programme Highways and Procurement consider and explore the most cost effective and compliant route to market for each highway commission. Due to the specialist nature of this work as well as capacity and skill set challenges which exist within the 'In House Highway Maintenance service' which operate out of Hooper Street Depot, we are unable to go in-house for this work. In addition, they had to decline this work to procure through their supply chain due to them re procuring their TC056 framework.
