What is the decision?	To give Capital Expenditure approval of £543,000 to implement a number of interventions to help improve safety and perception of safety along the route
Reasons for the decision (but excluding any exempt or confidential information)	The approval of capital expenditure to create safer and more accessible environments for people to walk and cycle, improving aspects of perceived and actual personal security by creating a safe environment for pedestrians and cyclists. This will be achieved with measures such as, improved lighting, signage, access control, improved entrances, and other works.
Alternatives considered and rejected	Through the development of the Manchester Cycleway designs, various options have been considered. Initially the scheme was going to deliver 13.25km of lighting but consultation with local community groups determined this option was unlikely to resolve problems associated with the route. Additionally, an Ecology survey showed that lighting would disturb local wildlife and fauna.
